

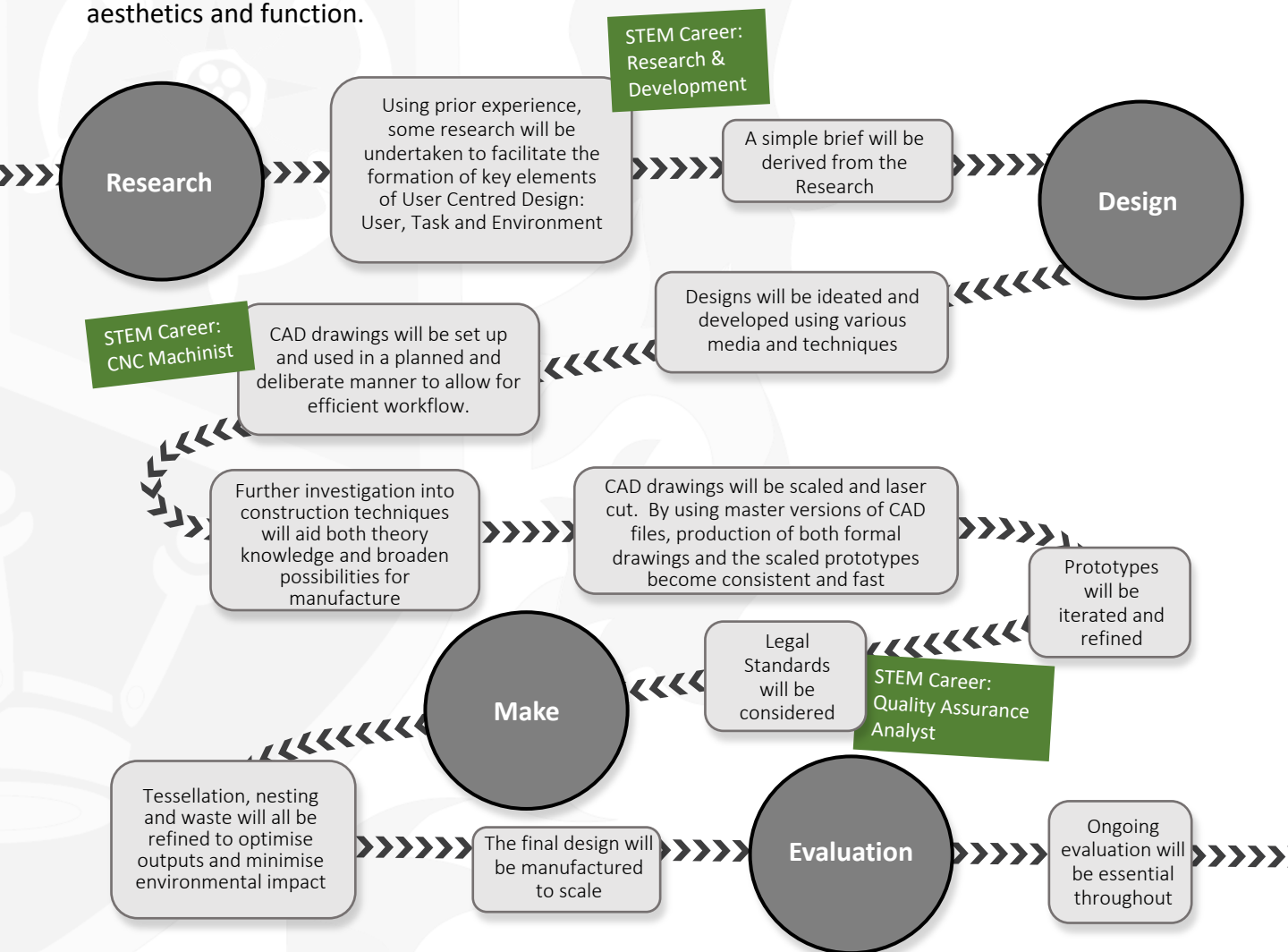

You will experience your final opportunity to complete a project before commencing your NEA. This project is intended to focus you on the importance of prototyping, leading to presenting a final idea using various formal drawings. You will need to work more **independently** than in previous projects and you will have more ownership of the brief you create. This project truly gives you an opportunity to demonstrate your ability to **self regulate**, plan and execute a far more complex product than previously experienced, requiring a careful balance between aesthetics and function.



TUDOR HABITS AND VALUES: Self regulation will be extremely important as you should be demonstrating significant amounts of independence.
