**Re: Year Nine Health Review 2019/20.**

The Department of Health recommends that children in year nine receive a health review by the School Nursing Team. This allows your child the opportunity to raise any concerns they might have in regards to their health and wellbeing, so that the School Nursing Team can help to address and support any unmet health needs.

In order to achieve this, your son/ daughter will have the opportunity to complete a simple online questionnaire about their general, physical and emotional health and wellbeing. Although anonymous information may be shared with other agencies to improve services, all personal information collected from this questionnaire will be treated as confidential.

The completed questionnaire will be assessed by a qualified nurse to identify any current or potential health needs that the School Nursing Team can help to address and support. The School Nurse may offer your child an appointment at a drop in session in school.
