This year we are working with EqualiTeach (www.equaliteach.co.uk) as part of their Equally Safe Programme which has been funded by the Department for Education and has been designed to support schools to take a whole school approach to preventing and tackling bullying, with a specific focus on identity-based bullying.

The programme will help us to:

- Further embed the Tudor Values of tolerance, unity, democracy, opportunity and respect
- Ensure that our policies and procedures are robust and actively support anti-bullying work
