
World Book Day is on Thursday 7th March. We began our celebrations this week with an assembly about how to read as a hobby.

To celebrate as a school community there are three key initiatives for all students to get involved with w/b 4th March:

Read a story in a day (KS3/4): All teachers will be sharing the short story: 'Lamb to the Slaughter' by Roald Dahl for the first ten minutes of each lesson so that by the end of the day, the whole school will have experienced a whole story together.

All staff will be carrying a book that they enjoy reading and we are inviting students to stop and ask the staff about their book choices as they move around the site.

Register, Read, Respond: The tutor time reading sessions provide the opportunity for students to hear the blurbs of the short books that have been published for World Book Day that they can buy with their book tokens. 
