<b>Data</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Produce and <i>interpret</i>: pictograms; <i>bar charts</i>, bar-line charts; vertical line charts; line graphs for time–series data; stem and leaf (TG1)</li> <li>- Write simple lists and combinations (TG1)</li> <li>- Recognise types of data (TG2)</li> <li>- Understand sample and population, bias, how sample sizes affect reliability, identify sources of bias and plan to minimise it (TG2)</li> <li>- Produce and interpret: composite bar charts; dual/comparative bar charts for categorical and ungrouped discrete data (TG2)</li> <li>- <i>Calculate the averages and range for discrete data (TG2)</i></li> <li>- Interpret two way tables and frequency trees (TG2)</li> <li>- <i>Draw and interpret pie charts (TG3)</i></li> <li>- Construct/design a two-way table (TG4)</li> <li>- Design and use data-collection sheets (TG4)</li> <li>- Interpret and find a range of averages: median, mean and range from a (discrete) frequency table; mode and range from a bar chart; median and range from stem and leaf diagrams (TG4)</li> <li>- Evaluate different measures of average (TG4)</li> <li>- Evaluate charts on their appropriate-ness (TG4)</li> <li>- Draw scatter graphs; <b>draw the line of best fit by eye</b>, and understand what it represents (TG4)</li> <li>- Identify all permutations and combinations in a scenario (TG4)</li> <li>- Construct and <b>interpret grouped frequency tables for continuous data</b>; for grouped data: find the interval containing the median and <b>modal class</b>; <b>estimate the mean (TG5)</b></li> <li>- <b>Use line of best fit to predict values of a variable (TG5)</b></li> <li>- <b>Understand all types of correlation; interpret scatter graphs in terms of the relationship; interpret correlation in terms of the problem.
