### Year 11 (Autumn 1)

#### Linguistic Competence

- I can talk about jobs, career choices and charity / volunteer work
- I can talk about my future ambitions
- I can talk about future post 16 study

#### Application of Grammar

- I can use tengo que and soler plus infinitive
  - I can use –er, -ir, -ar verbs in the preterite tense
  - I can use the imperfect tense
  - I can use the key irregular verbs (*ir* and *ser*)
  - I can use *ir* + infinitive to form the future tense
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### Year 11 (Autumn 2)

#### Linguistic Competence

- I can describe facilities in the town and what activities you can do
- I can give a range of reasons to justify opinions
- I can compare living in the countryside and the town
- I can give directions
- I can buy in the shops

#### Application of Grammar

- I can use 'se puede' + infinitive
- I can use the superlatives 'lo mejor' and 'lo peor'
- I can use the comparative
- I can use the conditional tense
- I can use the preterite and imperfect tense

### Year 11 (Spring 1)

#### Linguistic Competence

- I can describe my house
- I can describe how people can help the environment
- I can describe global issues
- I can talk about natural disasters

#### Application of Grammar

- I can use *se* + third person verbs and modal verbs (e.g. *poder* / *deber*)
  - I can give detailed opinions for and against
  - I can use three tenses together
  - I can understand and use trigger phrases with key subjunctive verbs
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### Year 11 (Spring 2)

#### Linguistic Competence

- I can discuss healthy diets
- I can discuss addictions
- I can discuss the impact of big sporting events

#### Application of Grammar

- I can use 'suelo' + infinitive
- I can use the present, imperfect tense and future tense together
- I can use structures with two verbs
