



## **Age of students**

Students enter the Sixth Form in Year 12 in the September after they reach the age of sixteen and leave at the end of Year 13.

## **Date of application**

The Academy has set the deadline of Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2019 for the receipt of internal and external applications to enable it to plan timetabling and staffing. Applications are available to parents and students on the Academy website.

## **Late applications**

Applications received after the closing date are late and will be considered after applications that were received on time.

## **Admission requirement**

The admission requirements for Year 11 Tudor Grange Academy students and external students will be the same.

## **Students choosing to study four A levels\***

If you wish to study four A levels you must achieve: Six GCSE's at grade 7 or above. Mathematics and English at grade 6 or above.

## **Students choosing to study three A Levels**

If you wish to study three A levels you must achieve: Six GCSE's at grade 6 or above. Mathematics and English at grade 5 or above.

All A Level courses will require students to achieve a minimum of a 6 grade in all examined units of the GCSE course

**In addition to their A levels students will be expected to broaden their experiences by choosing at least one of the following options:**

- Completing the Extended Project Qualification.
- Completing the Core Maths Qualification.
- Opting to undertake a one day per week industry placement.
- Participating in Academy enrichment opportunities.
- Attending mentor sessions to prepare them for university entry tests such as UKCAT, LNAT etc.

Additional requirements for specific courses are given in the Sixth Form Curriculum section of the Academy website.

Potential applicants are advised to study the additional requirements for specific subjects or courses.





## Offers of places to join the Sixth Form

Tudor Grange Academy Year 11 students and external applicants who submit an application by the published deadline will be offered a place in the Sixth Form, subject to them meeting the entrance requirements. It should be noted that this is an offer of a **place**, and **not a specific course of study**.

The Academy undertakes to reserve 30 places for external students, subject to them meeting the entry requirements.

Tudor Grange Academy reserves the right to withdraw courses that are undersubscribed and similarly to limit numbers of students on courses that are oversubscribed.

## Late Applicants

Applications received after the published deadline will be dated and offers of places will be made subject to applicants meeting the entry requirements and providing there are available places. This will be done once all on time applicants have enrolled.

## Acceptance of places

Acceptance of places by applicants takes place on GCSE results day and the following day.

Detailed arrangements will be published on the Academy website. Places not accepted on those days will be assumed to have been declined.

External students must attend in person to accept their place, bringing evidence of their GCSE results.

## Oversubscription criteria for the Sixth Form

Where applications exceed the number of places available, the following oversubscription criteria will be applied in the order of priority set out below. All applicants will have to meet the academic admission requirements:

- Children looked after by a Local Authority (in line with section 22 of the Children Act) and previously looked after children who are now adopted.
- Children closest to the school, measured in a straight line from child's home.

## Application appeals

Appeals for Sixth Form applications will be heard within forty school days of the appeal being lodged.
