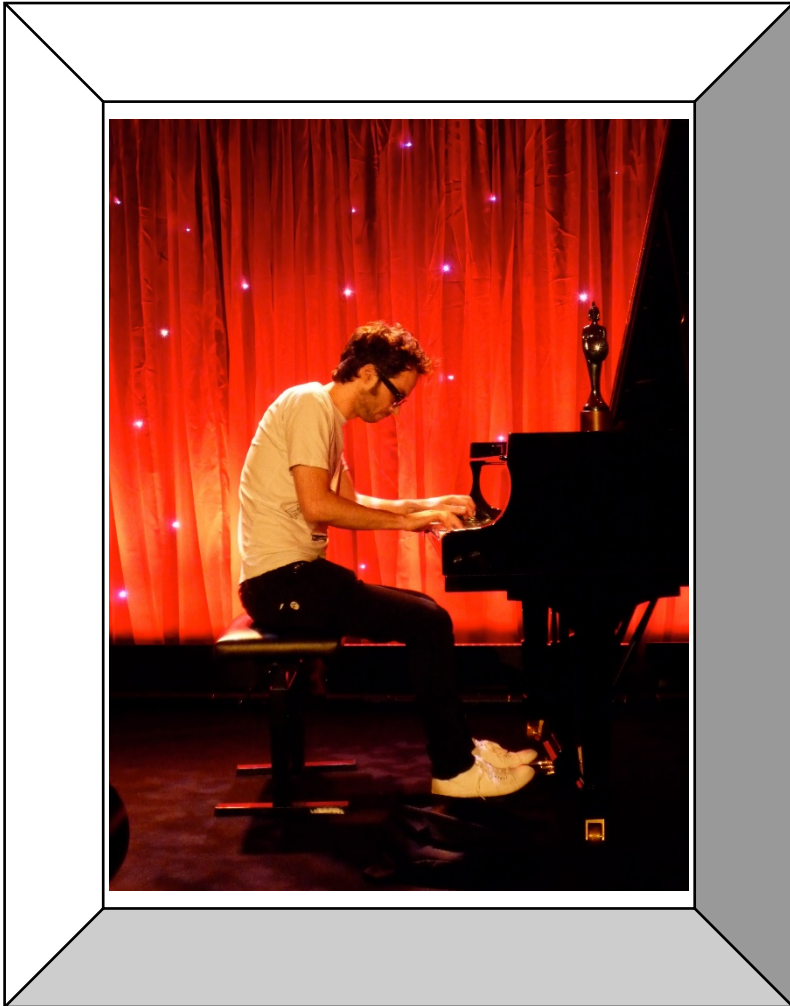


Element of Course

Performing

Total duration: 4-6 minutes

A minimum of two pieces, one of which must be an ensemble performance of a least one minute duration. One piece must link to an area of study.

Element of Course

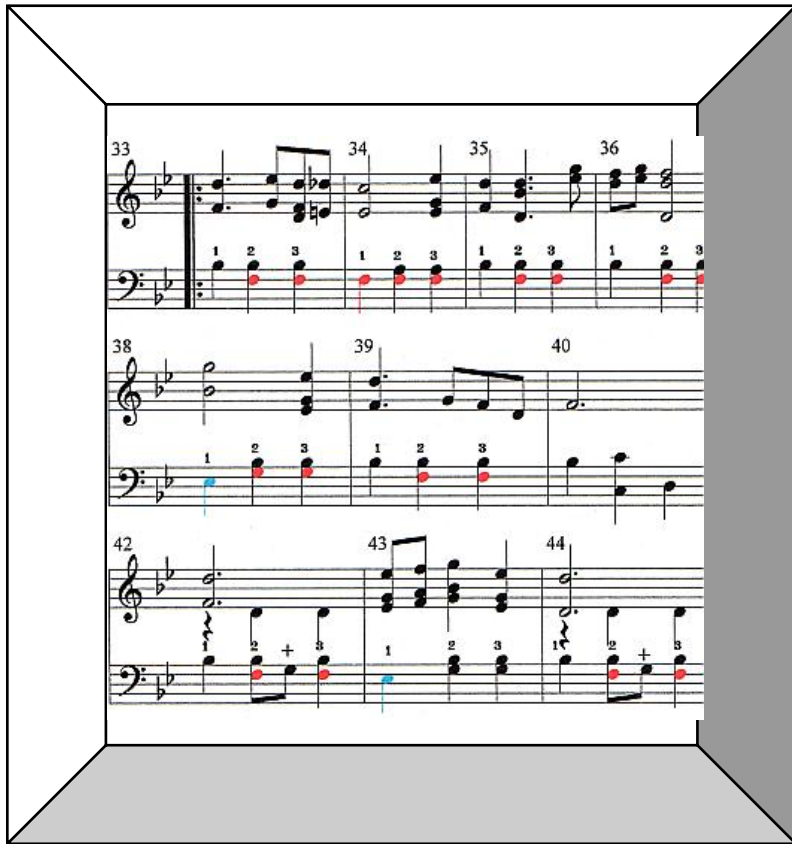
Composing

Total Duration: 3-6 minutes

Two compositions, one in response to a brief set by Eduqas. Pupils will set their own brief for the second composition.

Written examination: 1hr 15 minutes

Eight questions in total, two on each area of study
