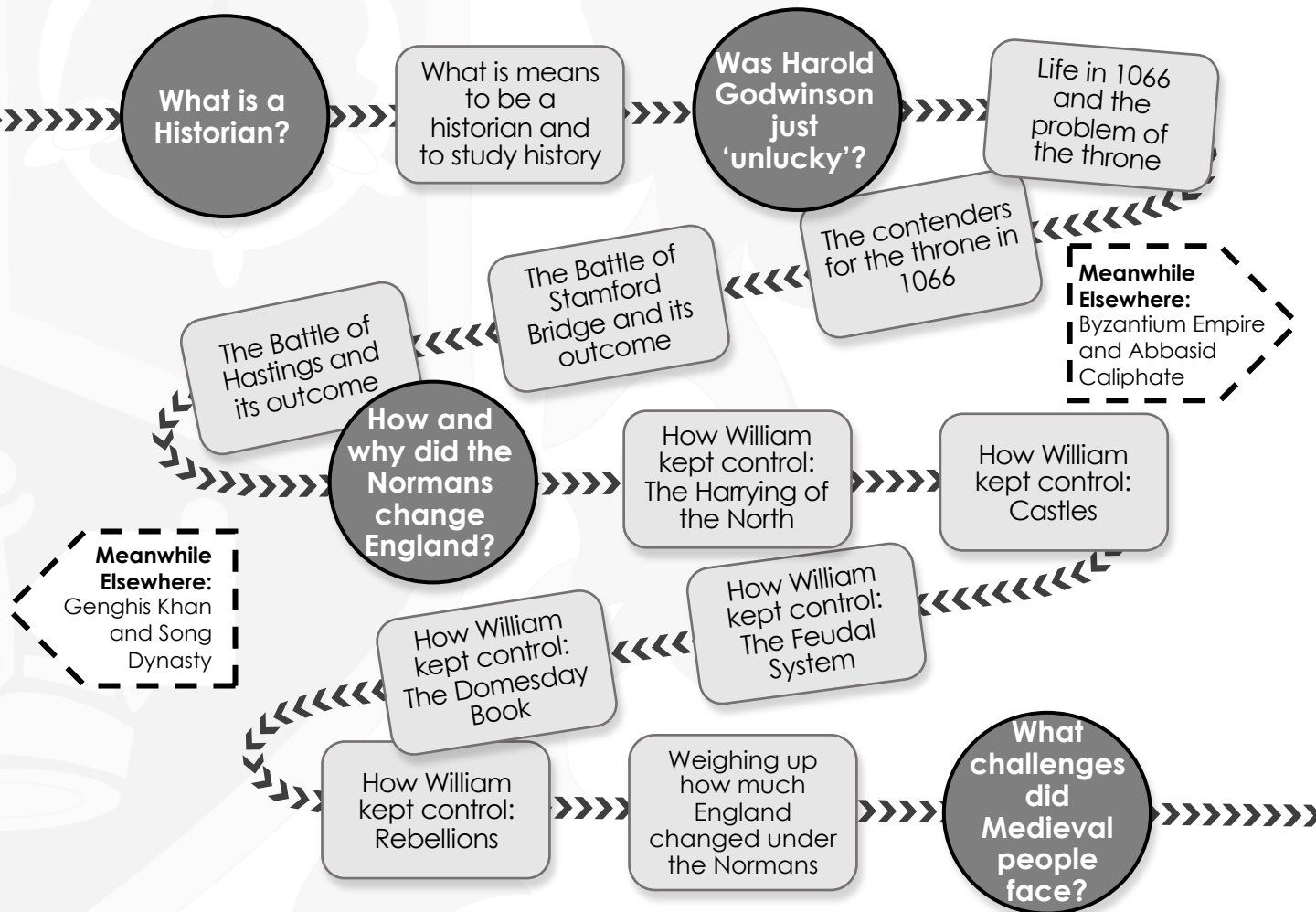


Year 7: Power and Control

Autumn Term

You are going to develop your knowledge of the events of the **medieval and early modern world**, with a focus on the challenges facing **Medieval people and their rulers**. You will use this knowledge to develop your understanding of **different types of power and control**. This will also help to prepare you for our Year 8 '**Democracy**' topic, where we look at how **ordinary people** were able to gain more power.

You're going to develop your **describing** and **explaining** skills and understand a little more what it means to use **sources** like a historian, providing you with the key basic skills you need to **think and write like a historian**, whilst arguing like a lawyer!
