


Year 10: Early Elizabethan England, 1558-88 and Medicine Through Time, C1250-Present Spring Term

This final unit of your Elizabeth paper explores what **Elizabethan society** was like during the period **1558 to 1588**. You will then move onto your **Medicine topic**, learning about the **development of ideas** relating to **medicine** over the last **one thousand years**.

In your Medieval and Renaissance Medicine topics you will continue to develop the skills you've been practicing on your Elizabeth paper; **describing**, **explaining** and sustained **analysis** before reaching a substantiated **conclusion**. The difference here is that you will be making comparisons between the different time periods.

Due to the focus on analysis, there are excellent links here to a career in **law** and **journalism**, as well as the obvious links to a career in **medicine**.
