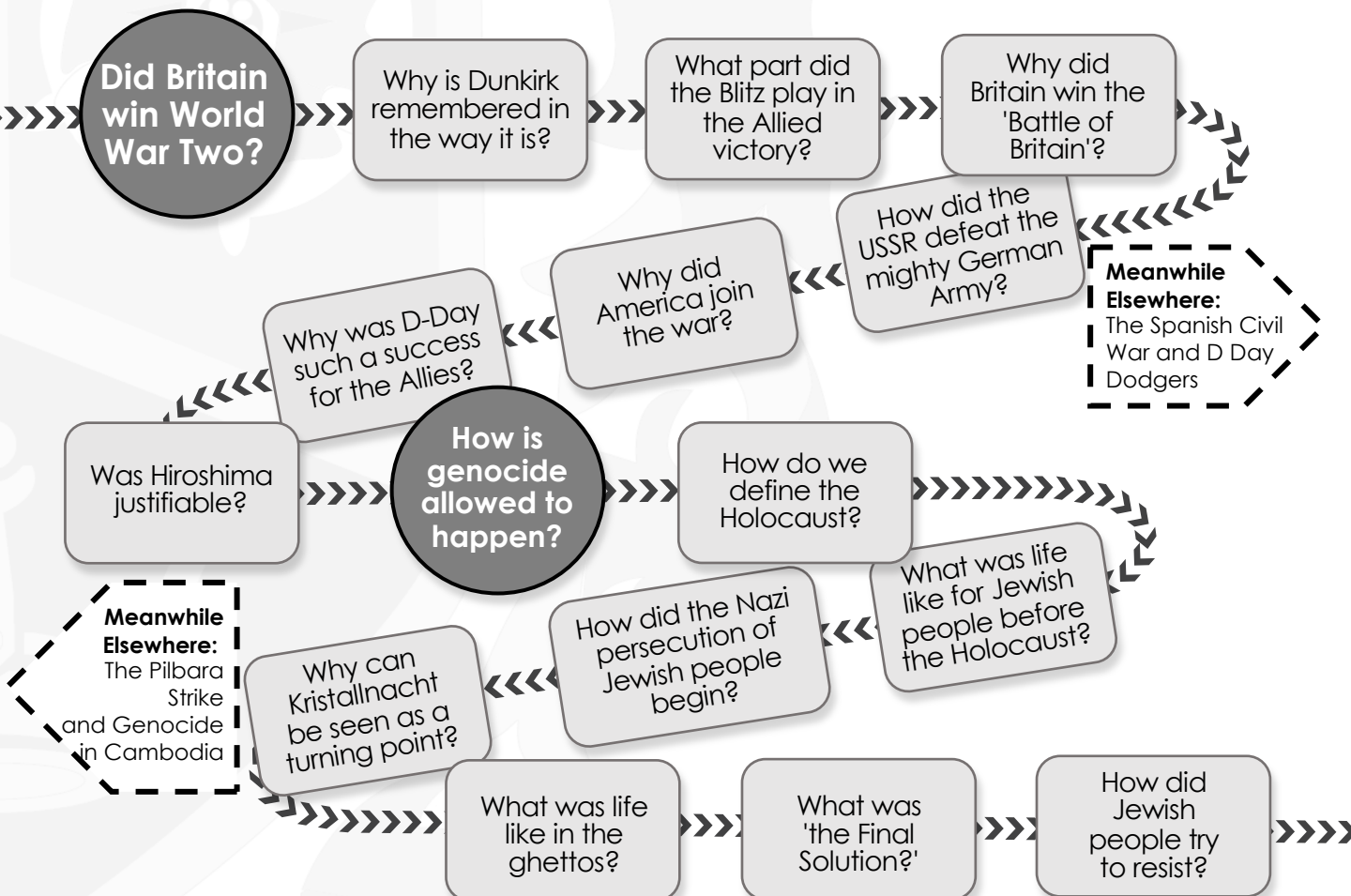


Year 9: Conflict and Progress

Autumn Term

You are going to further develop your knowledge of **global Twentieth Century events** by looking at the **key events of World War Two**. You will use this knowledge to develop your understanding of key concepts such as **conflict** and **progress**. As part of this World War Two topic, you will begin to look at the Holocaust and other, more recent, genocides. This will include how such events have been able to happen repeatedly throughout History whilst further considering the nature of **race**.

You will continue to use your developing knowledge to complete **extended writing** with **consistent analysis** throughout to come to a **substantiated conclusion**, in the same way that a **journalist** would. This more modern history will support you in putting current times into context.



TUDOR HABITS: As part of this topic, you will develop your understanding of how lack of **unity** and **tolerance** can lead to conflict, as well as how **democracy** can be threatened and eroded. You will also investigate what the consequences of this can be for the citizens of the countries involved.
