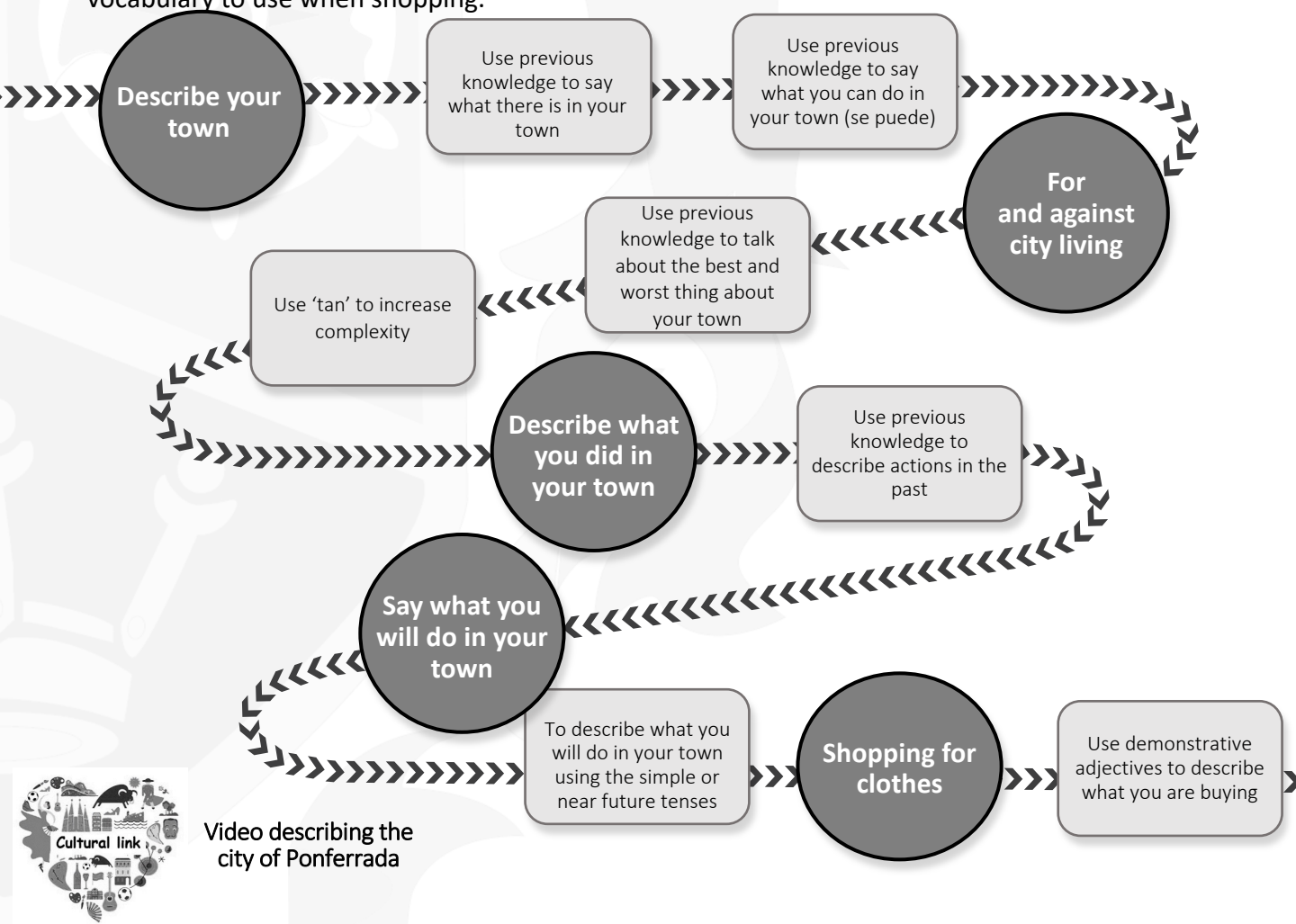


LEARNING JOURNEY SPANISH

Mi ciudad (My town)

Year 11 Autumn Term 2

In the topic of town you will revisit key tenses that you have previously learnt (present, preterite, imperfect and near future) and you will also incorporate the simple future tense to make your work more sophisticated. Therefore, the topic of town is perfect to revisit key vocabulary and tenses. You will be using impersonal structures like 'se puede' that you learnt in KS3 and you will use present tense to describe your town, but you will be able to add complexity with the use of the comparative 'tan' (so + adjective). You will explore advantages and problems in cities and you will give your opinion on the best and worst thing about a town using 'lo mejor/lo peor.' again adding further complexity. Towards the end of the topic you will learn useful vocabulary to use when shopping.
