

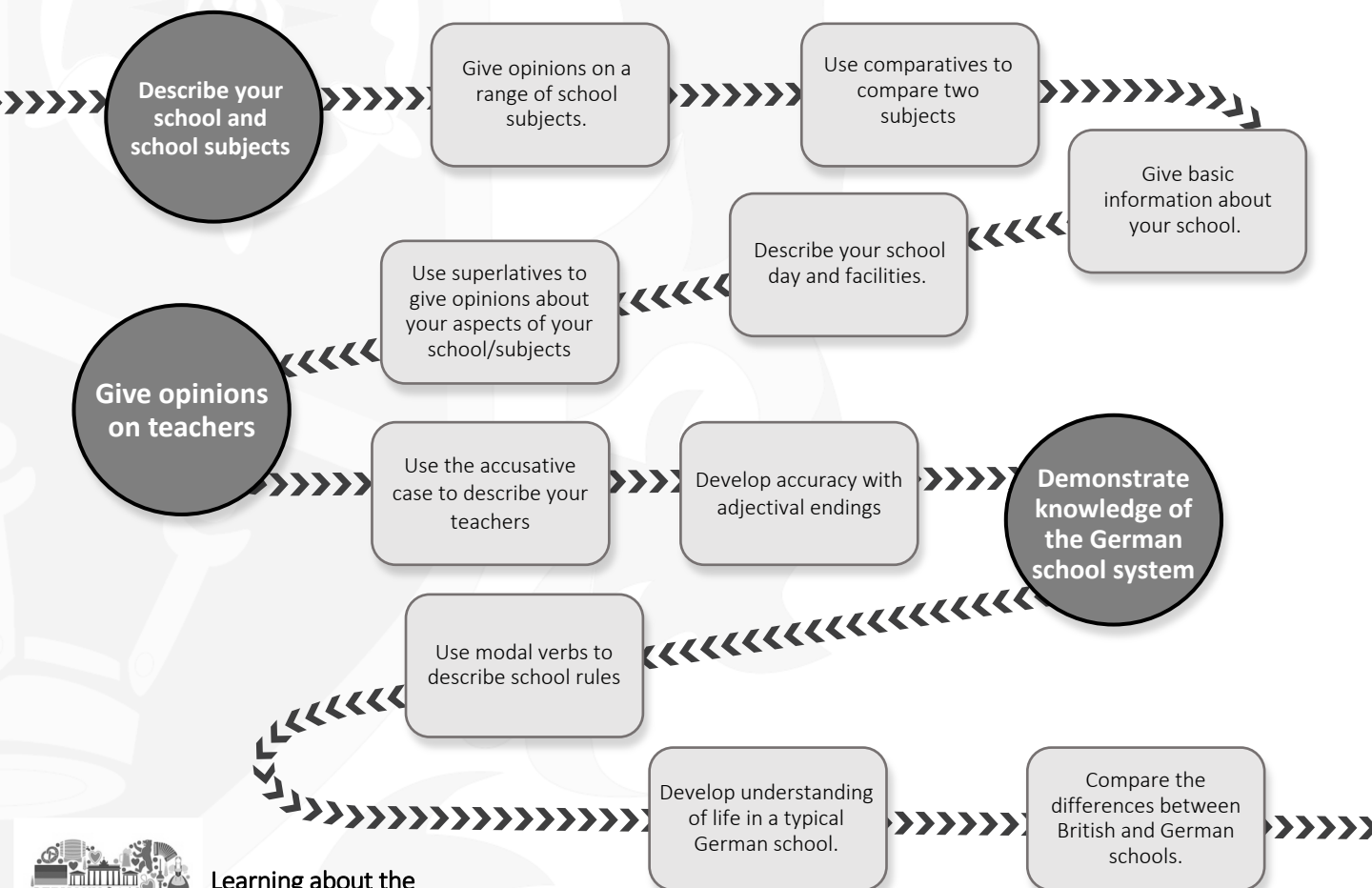
LEARNING JOURNEY

This topic draws on language and structures that you covered in years 7 and 8. For example, it builds on basic school vocabulary from year 7, as well as developing and consolidating a range of opinion phrases. It is important to develop a range of language as well as your accuracy, so learning differing, more complex ways of expressing opinions will be key to your study within this unit of work and beyond. Moreover, this unit serves as a starting point for the "world of work" topic, which will be covered in year 11, with much of the vocabulary and structures recycled when we consider post 16 study. In addition, you will learn more about life in German schools and develop and expand your knowledge of the German school system. There are a large number of differences, including the timings of the school day, uniform and even the subjects that are studied.
