Year 10 Autumn Term 1

In Year 9 you have covered the topics that linked to GCSE content and allowed you to make progress in essential GCSE grammar and language structures. You have covered the main present, preterite and future tenses in year 9 and you now have the linguistic understanding to deepen your understanding of these essential tenses but are also extending sentences and giving more varied opinions and reasons. These will include the use of comparatives and superlatives for example. The topic of holidays builds on free time linguistic structures from year 9. By the end of this topic you will be able to refer to past, present and future events competently in the context of holidays.

Carry out transactional tasks such as booking a hotel room
