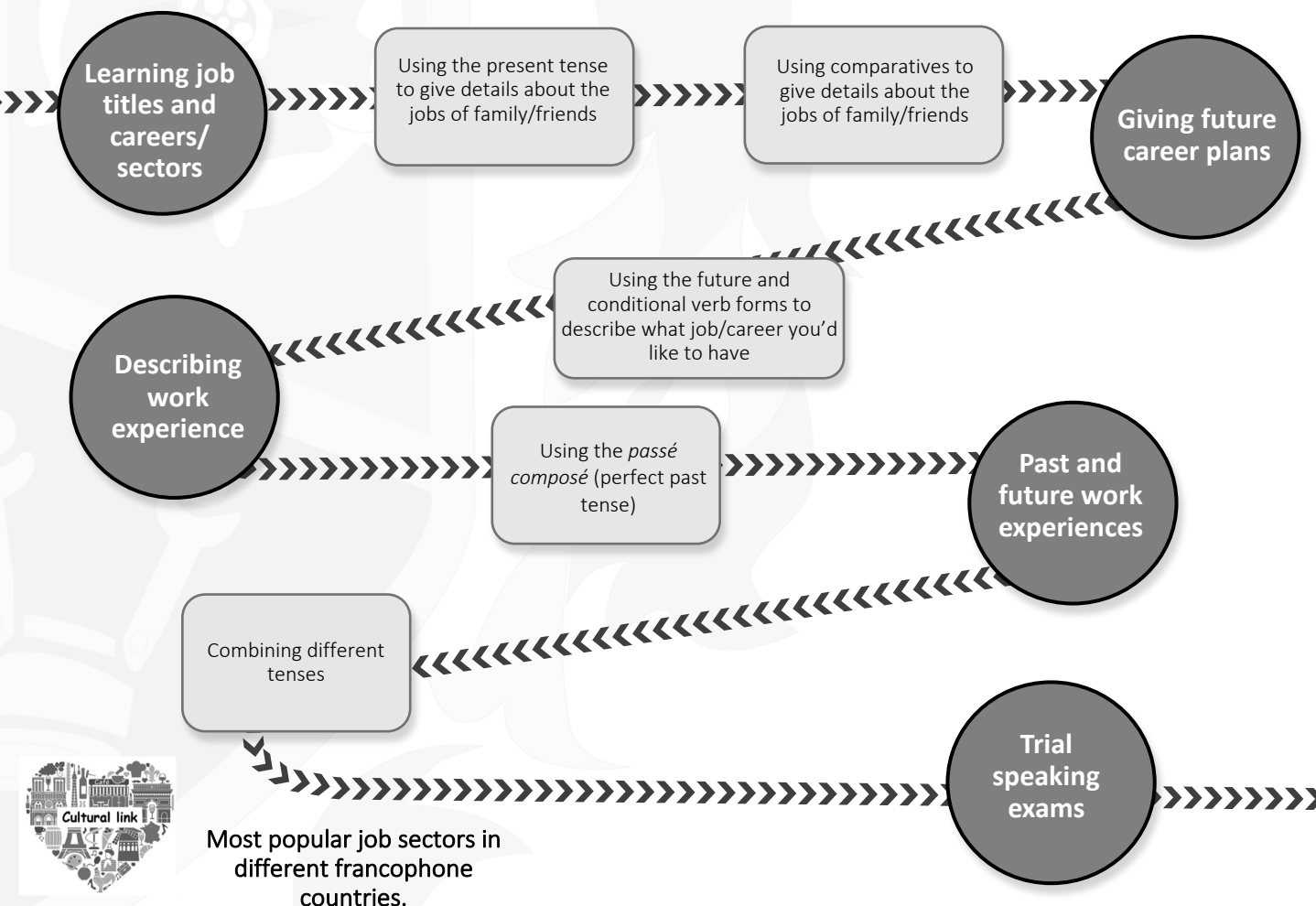


LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH

Le monde du travail (the world of work)

Year 11 Autumn Term 1

In Years 7-10 we have already covered the present, past, and future tenses. This topic is a good opportunity at the start of Year 11 to recap all three of these tenses, as well as to look again at the conditional verb form and extended opinions (comparatives). The 'conditional' is a verb form linked to the English 'would' and talks about future plans, wishes, and desires. The *passé composé* is the 'perfect past tense' and has been used in all previous GCSE topics, and will be used in this topic to describe work experience. Describing work and careers is an important part of your school life generally and you will gain and insight into the differences between main industries in France/the French-speaking world.
