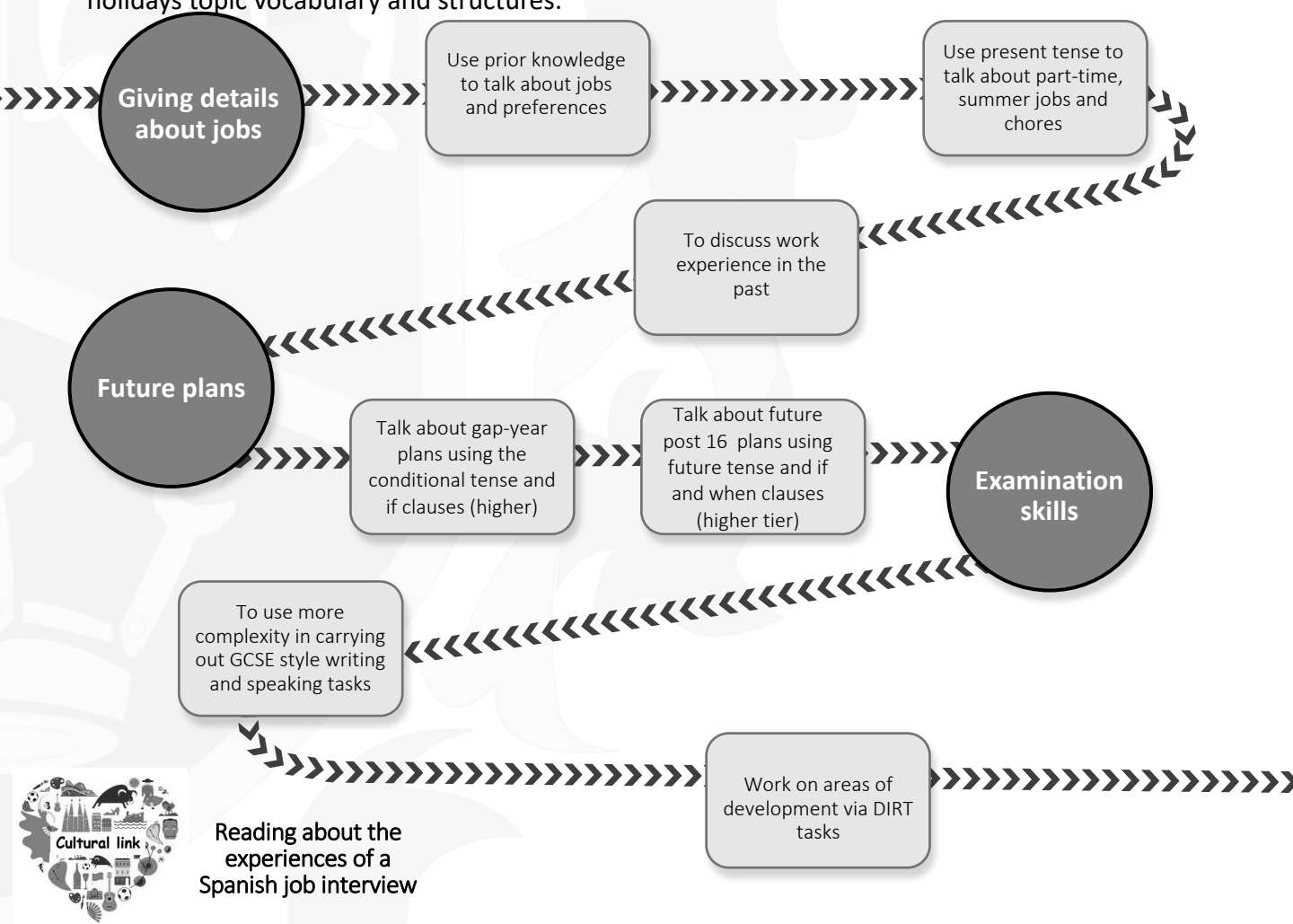


LEARNING JOURNEY SPANISH

You have covered the main present, preterite and future tenses and you now have the linguistic understanding to cope with more complex sentences such as the using if and when clauses. By the end of this topic you will be able to refer to past, present and future events, showing greater knowledge of how to add complexity to future and conditional tense phrases. Although vocabulary for jobs is quite specific, when talking about gap year and future plans there is crossover with school and holidays topic vocabulary and structures.
