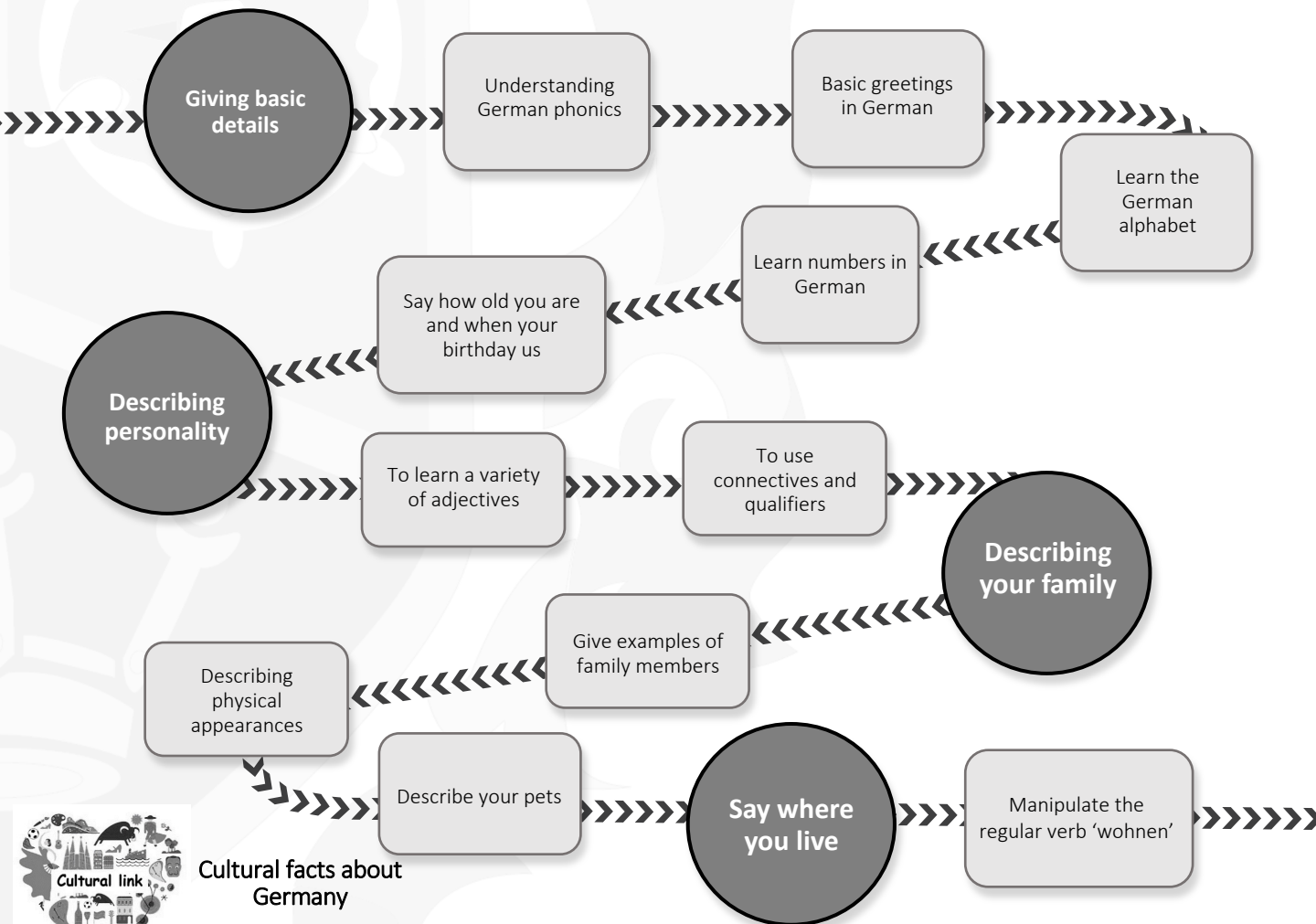


LEARNING JOURNEY German

During primary school you might have acquired some basic knowledge in a foreign language. Even if this is different to the language that you are studying now, this is a foundation for understanding patterns in language and different grammatical structures. This topic allows you to explore basic phrases in German as a novice learner. You will be exposed to lots of new German vocabulary in order to have simple conversations in German. As well as vocabulary and structures we will look at phonics to develop your understanding of the link between sounds and spellings in German. This topic contains lots of the most fundamental German vocabulary and structures that you need before progressing such as numbers, alphabet, introduction to genders and regular verb endings.
