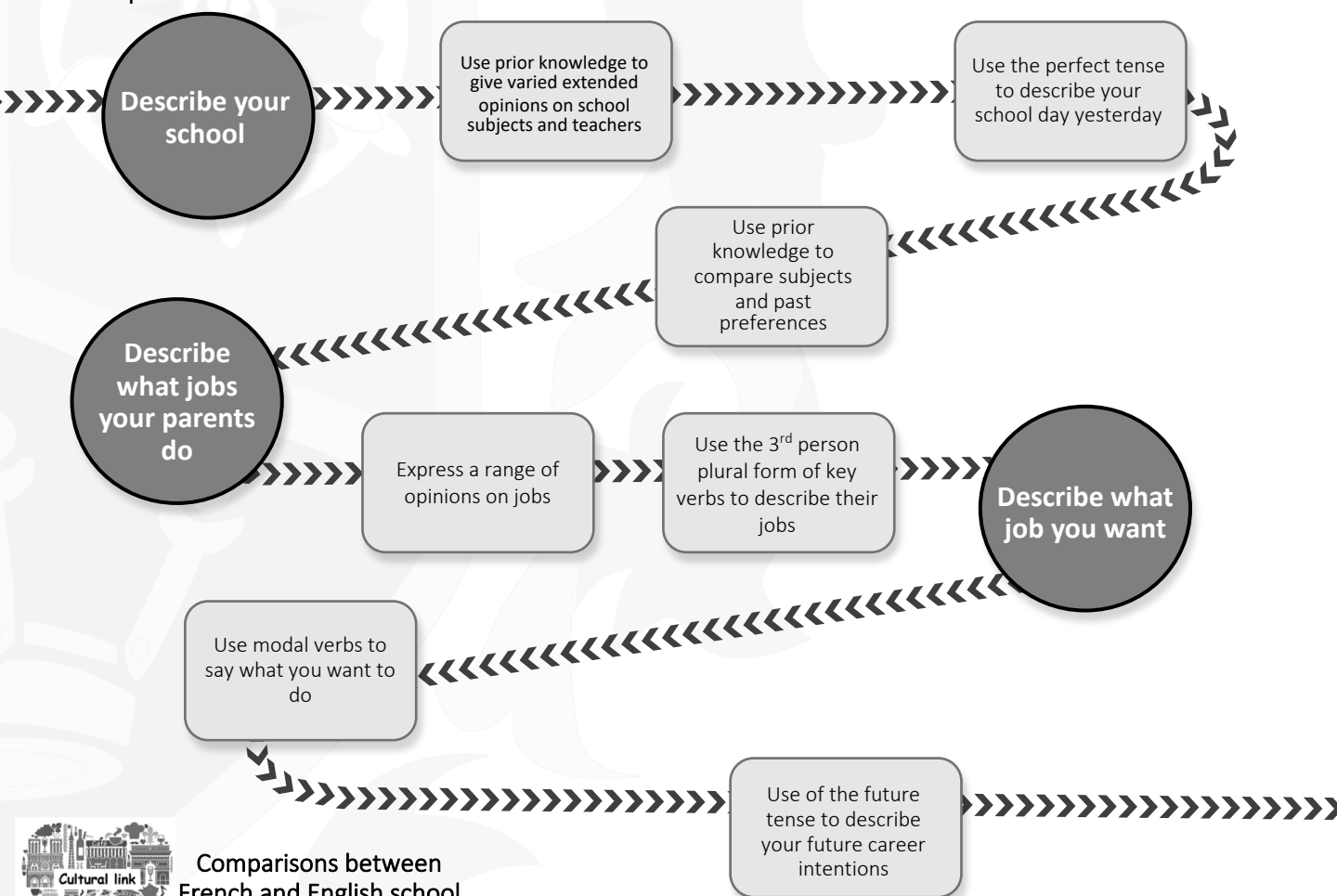


LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH

Le collège *et le travail* (School and work)

Year 9 Autumn Term 1

In Year 7 we covered giving opinions about our favourite subjects and describing our school day. We will be using new grammatical structures such as direct object pronouns (e.g. *le, la, les* in the structure '*je le trouve*') to revisit and build on the school vocabulary already mastered in year 7. Furthermore, as you were able to use all three tenses to talk about past, present and future celebrations at the end of year 8, you now have the linguistic understanding to refer to past, present and future academic preferences as well as your future intention for study and work. In year 8 you also practised discussing the musical and fashion preferences of others using the third person. In this unit of work, we will be building on your use of the third person plural to discuss our parent's job and their preferences.
