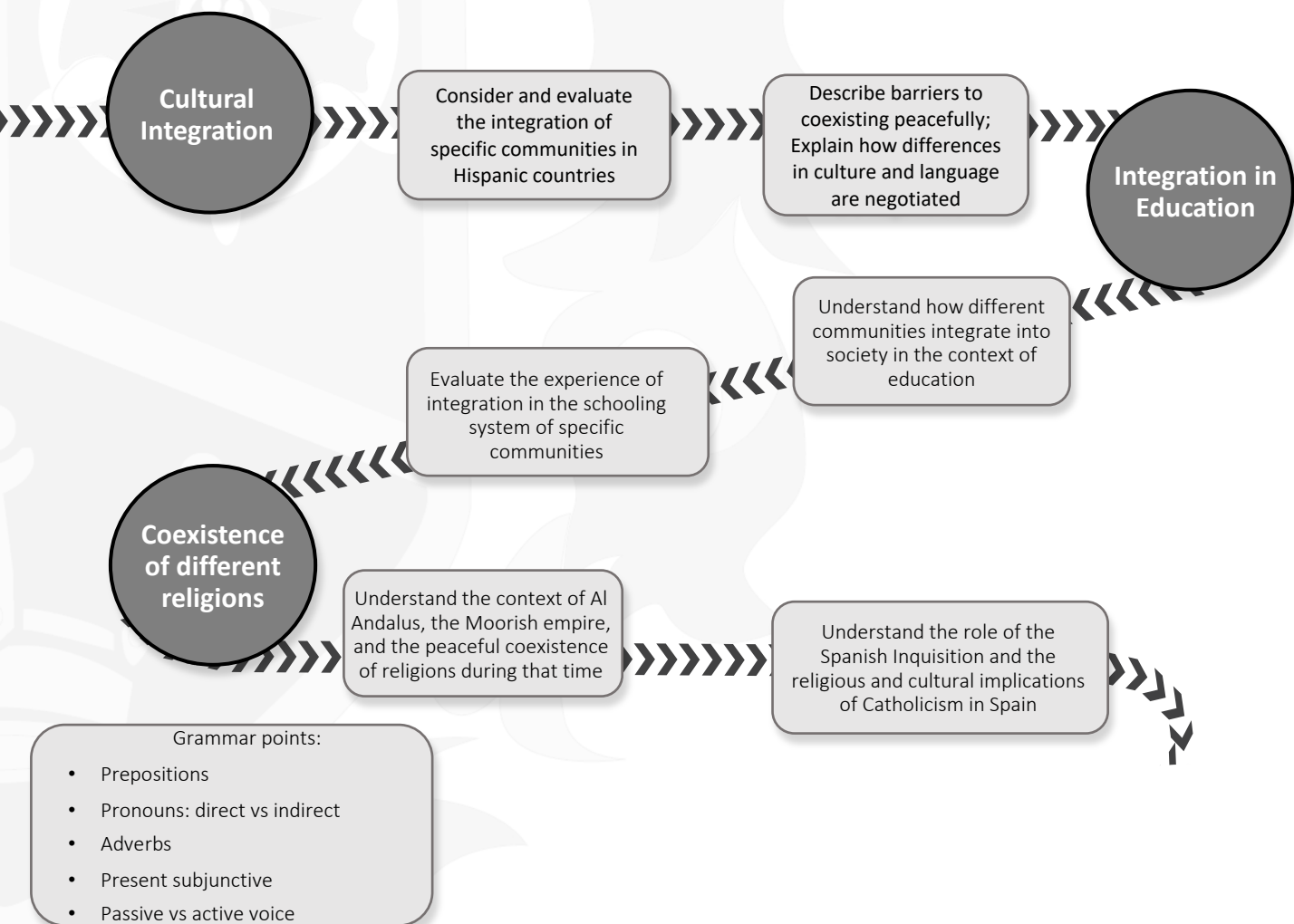
La Convivencia

Year 13 Spring Term 1

In Spring 1, you will build upon your knowledge of racism, discrimination and migrant groups and immerse yourself in their experience of integrating into the host country's culture by considering the experience of specific communities, such as the British community in southern Spain.

You will be able to evaluate barriers that have hindered their integration and assess how well they have integrated and adopted the host country's culture and language, by looking at different communities' experience in the education system.

You will deepen your understanding of the current situation of integration by comparing today with the Moorish history, a period in history in which the Jewish, Muslim and Christian community lived harmoniously under Muslim rule. You will understand what disrupted this period in history by studying the Spanish Inquisition and better understand its cultural and religious implications for modern day Spain.



TUDOR HABITS: By considering how education can aid or inhibit integration, students have the opportunity to develop empathy for these communities' struggles to find their place in a host country's society.
