What will we study?

Year 9: Introduction/specialism-RO18

- LO4 Understand how to recognise, manage and prevent childhood illnesses

How are these units assessed?

In terms of assessment, there are 3 components.



The first component is a written exam based on the Health and Well-Being for Child Development. This is worth 50% of the final grade. This will be taken at the end of year 11. This exam is 1 hour and 15 minutes long.

The second and third components are coursework where the student must create a portfolio to show their understanding in the following areas. This is also worth 50% of the final grade.

Assessment 1: Understanding the Equipment and Nutritional Needs of Children from Birth to Five Years (this is 25% of the final grade)

Assessment 2: Understanding the Development of a Child from Birth to Five Years (this is 25% of the final grade)
