

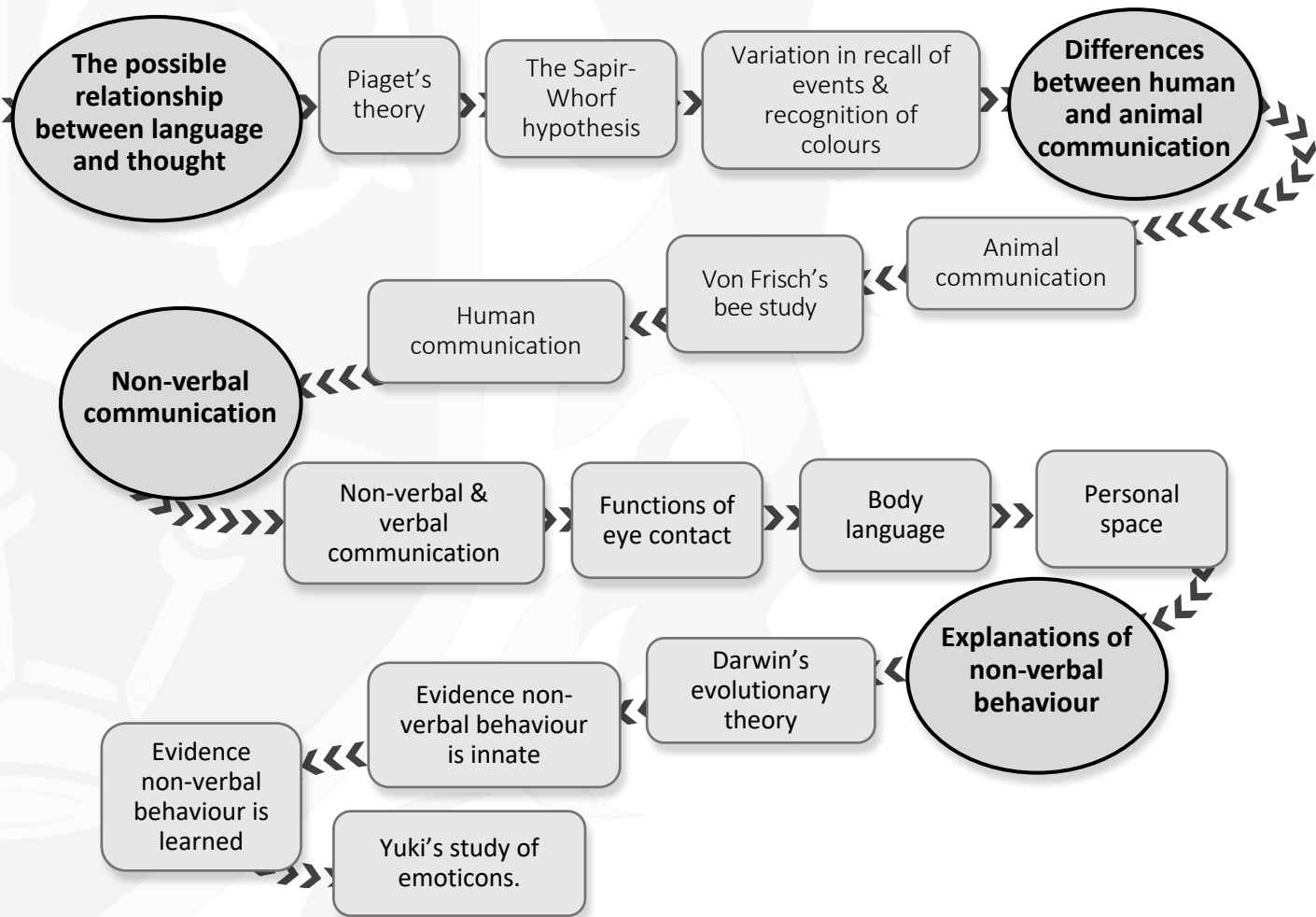

Language, thought & communication

Communication skills are crucial to life itself. You will develop your understanding of the relationship between thought & language, the differences between animal & human communication and human non-verbal communication. These skills will help you understand non-verbal cues in a variety of situations such as job interviews and presentations. Learning how verbal and non-verbal messages work is key for communicating with other people effectively.



TUDOR HABITS AND VALUES: You will have time to reflect on honesty and truthfulness looking at non-verbal communication. When verbal communication can be dishonest and untrue, NVC can act as important cues that someone is being deceitful.
