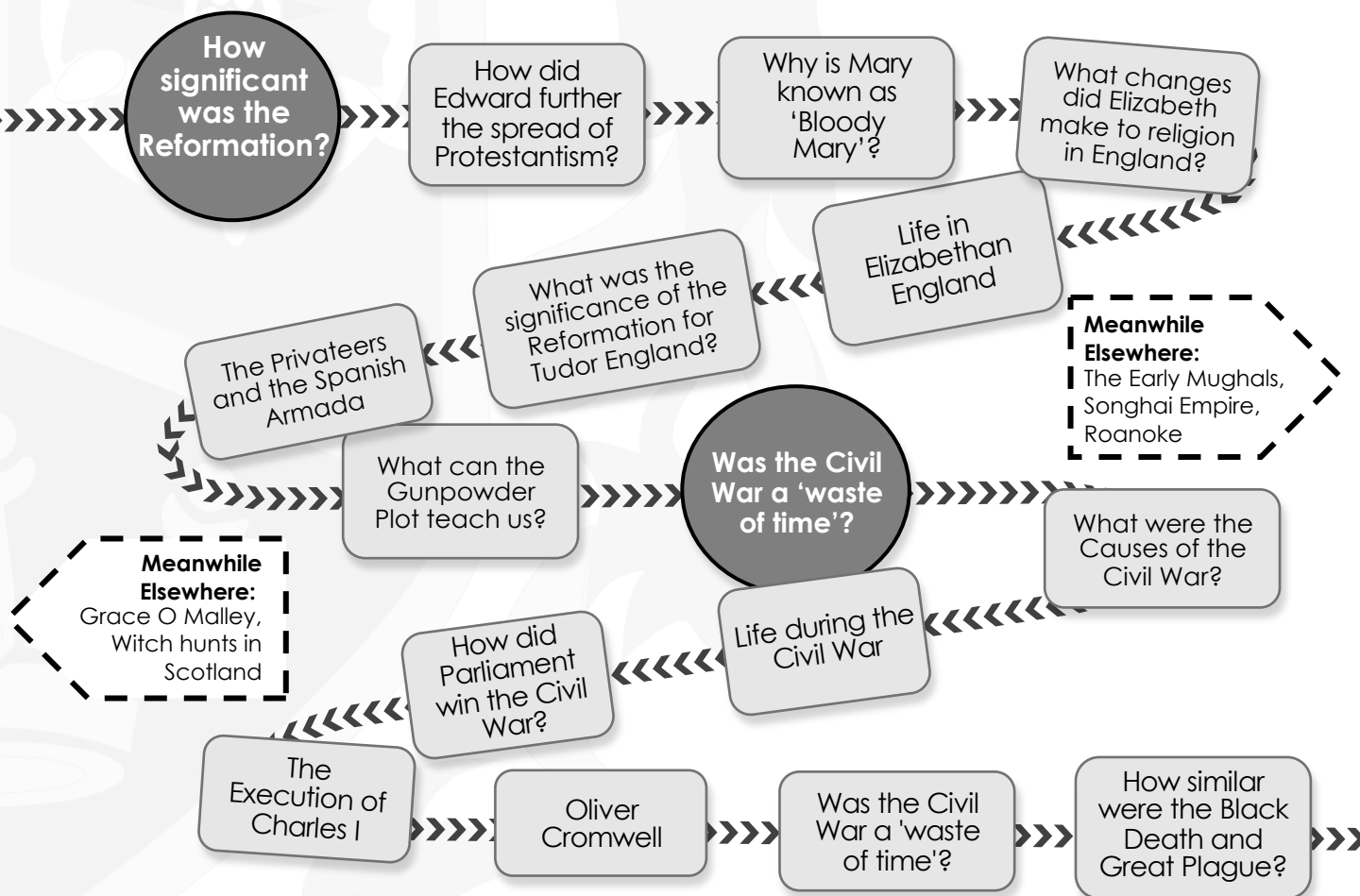


Year 7: Power, Control and Conflict

Summer Term

You are going to continue to develop your knowledge of the events of the **early modern world**, with a focus on the challenges facing **Medieval people and their rulers**. You will use this knowledge to develop your understanding of **the impact these challenges had** on an increasingly diverse number of people. This will continue to prepare you for our Year 8 '**Democracy**' topic, where we look at how **ordinary people** were able to gain more power, as well as our Year 8 'Empire' topic, as it is here we find the origins of the British Empire.

You're going to continue to develop your **describing** and **explaining** skills and as well as developing your ability to use **sources** like a historian. This will provide you with the key skills you need to **think and write like a historian**, whilst presenting different viewpoints, like a **diplomat**!.
