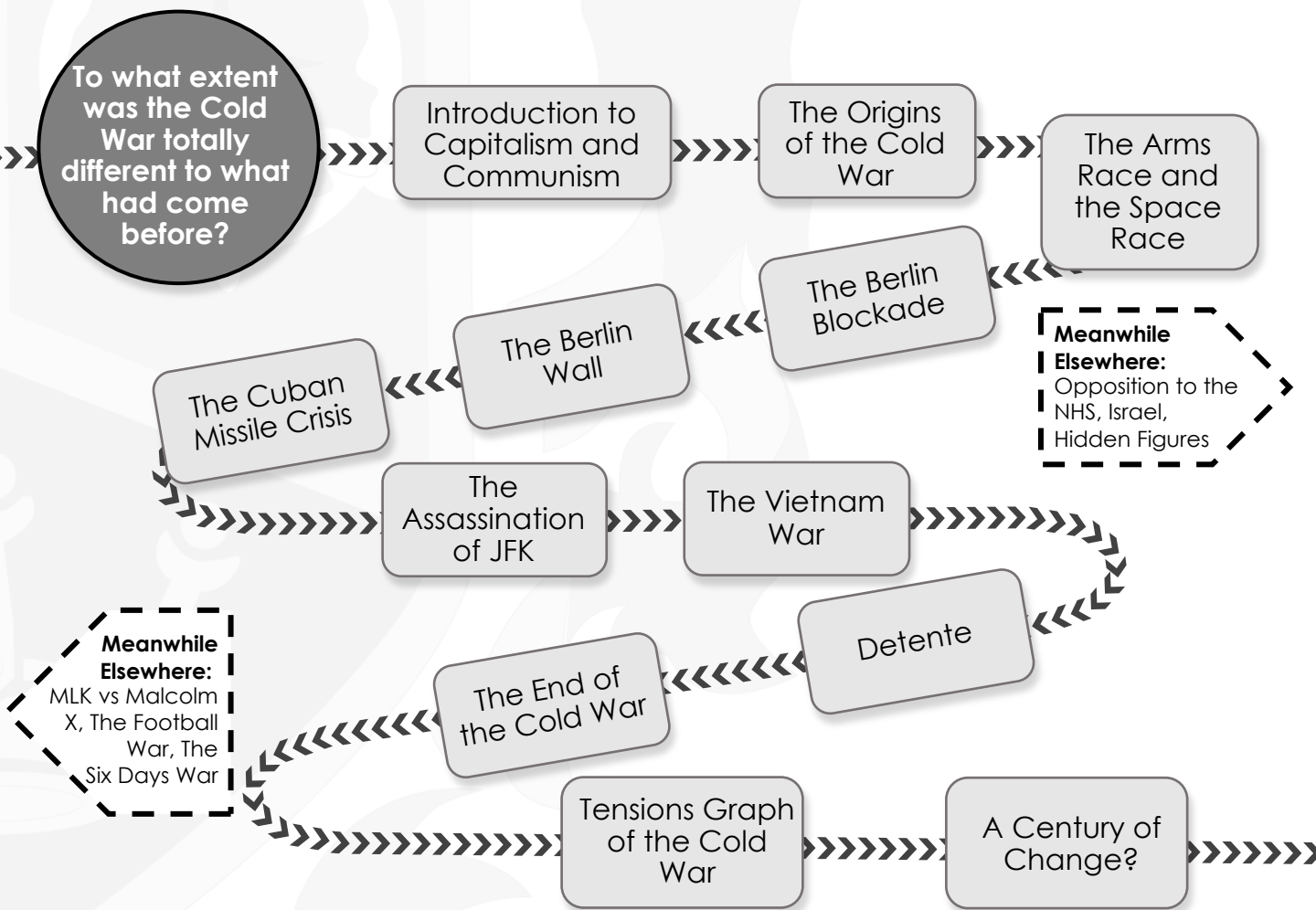


Year 9: Conflict and Progress

Summer Term

You will begin your **Cold War study**, which looks at the **global conflict** which resulted from the **opposing ideologies of the USA and USSR after 1945**. This study builds on your work investigating **conflict in the Twentieth Century**, and analysing how the nature of war has changed since 1900. In this way, we pick up the idea of **conflict** from Year 8.

You will continue to use your developing knowledge to complete **extended writing** with **consistent analysis** throughout to come to a **substantiated conclusion**, in the same way that a **journalist** would. This more modern history will support you in putting current times into context – understanding how the world came look as it currently does.



TUDOR HABITS: As part of this topic, you will develop your understanding of how lack of **unity** and **tolerance** can lead to conflict, as well as how **democracy** can be threatened and eroded. You will also investigate what the consequences of this can be for the citizens of the countries involved.
