Create a word cloud with all the different key issues and themes raised in 'The Great Gatsby'.	Read the opening of William Shakespeare's 'Othello' and record/film yourself performing one of lago's soliloquies.	Read 'The Great Gatsby' by F. Scott Fitzgerald and write a 500 word plot synopsis.
Create a time line of all the different movements in literature beginning with the 14 <sup>th</sup> century and ending with modern literature	Write a 300 word report explaining what 3 books you would take if you were deserted on a desert island and why.	Create a definition sheet of 20 different technical features a student can analyse in poetry (e.g. Rhyme, Assonance, etc.)
Research when William Shakespeare's 'Othello' was first performed and produce a 300 word summary of the historical context the play was set in.	Speak to at least 5 people and record what their favourite piece of literature is and why.	Create a 10 slide storyboard to display your understanding of the plot of either 'The Great Gatsby' or 'Othello'.
