Create a 'personal geography' map of your area. Include photographs, personal reflections and places of importance.	In 300 words explain what 'geography means to you'	Produce a series of graphs (line/bar/scatter) to show the economic growth of 3 countries at different levels of development
Read the geofile 'Coastal systems, waves, sediments and cells' and summarise on 1 side of A4 paper.	Ask 5 people what 'place' means to them. Produce a 300 word report of their findings	Produce a mind map of a case study of a recent natural disaster
