
LEARNING JOURNEY POLITICS

Spring Term

This unit will develop your knowledge and understanding of **government** in the **UK**, its **institutions**, their **roles**, **powers** and **interrelationships** with specific reference to the **Executive**, **Legislative** and **Judicial** functions of the UK system of governance. As well as this, you will be expected to study a further **political ideology**, including its **core ideas** and **principles**. In this case, this will be **Feminism**. (Feminism will be studied at the start of **year 13**.)

As part of this you will be developing your understanding of the **political theory** involved, but also develop a bank of **up to date cases studies** to exemplify what you have learned in relation to **modern politics in the UK.** This develops skills which would be beneficial for a career as **a political scientist** or in **law**.



PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT: Alongside your work investigating inequality, democracy and sovereignty, you will also develop your tolerance in engaging with the beliefs of others. You will explore reasoned views about ethical and controversial issues and be sensitive in the language you use.
