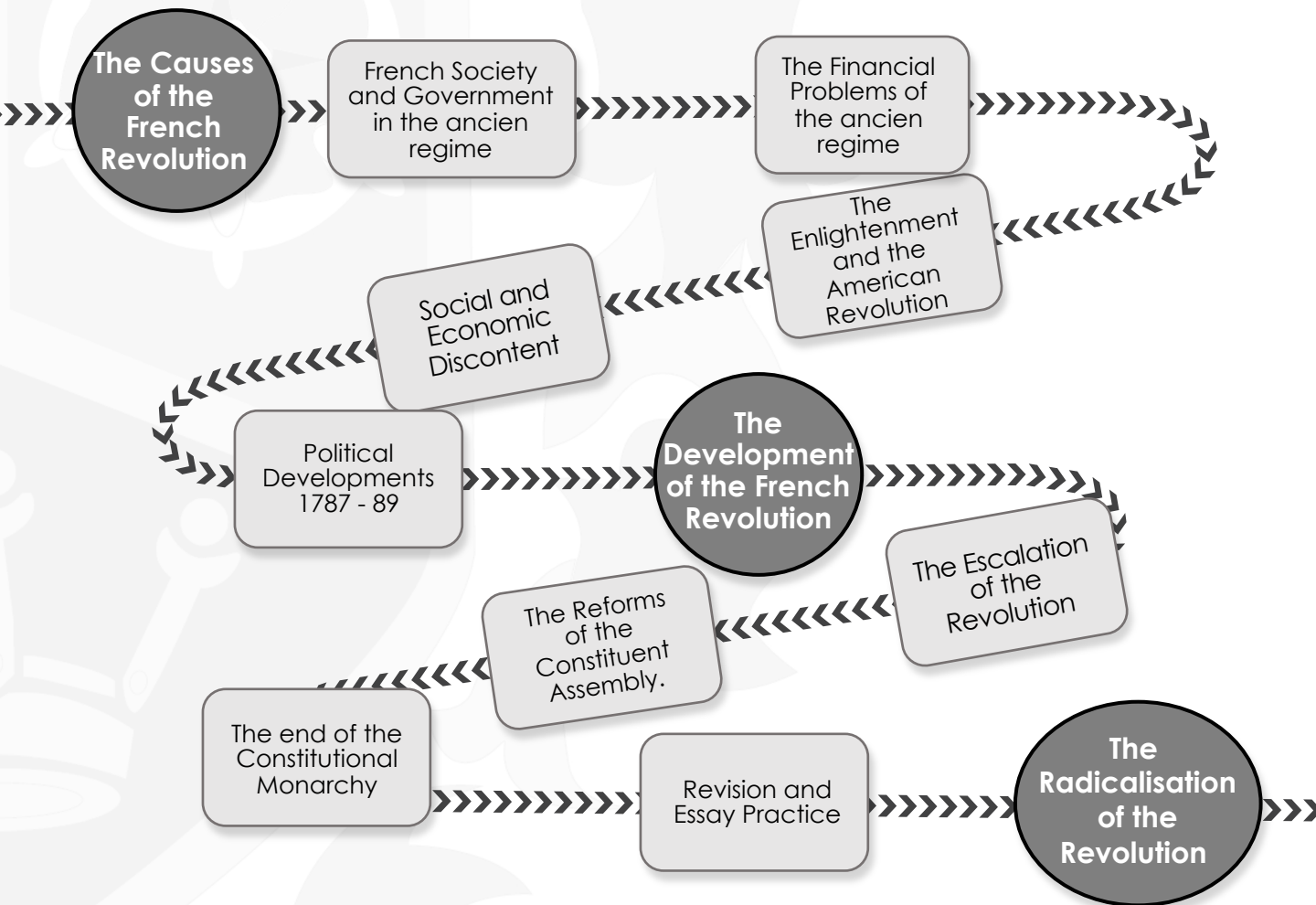


French Revolution and the rule of Napoleon 1774–1815

Autumn Term

You will develop your knowledge of the **causes** of the French Revolution in **1789**, analysing the **relative importance** of the **contributing factors**. You will investigate how the revolution **developed** from **1789 – 1792** and evaluate the **inevitability** of the failure of the **Constitutional Monarchy**.

During this process you will develop your understanding of what it means to be a **historian**, including the different **skills** and **processes** involved, as well as develop your **independence**, **self-regulation** and **metacognition** skills. There's also excellent links to a career in **political science** and **law**.



PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT: You will investigate **inequality** in society and different types of government (and how they can contribute to this). **Sovereignty** will be discussed as part of this. They will develop your understanding of what it means to be a **democratic citizen** and debate and deliberate about **societal issues**.

HISTORY VOCABULARY: ancien regime, Estates General, National Assembly, Constituent Monarchy.
