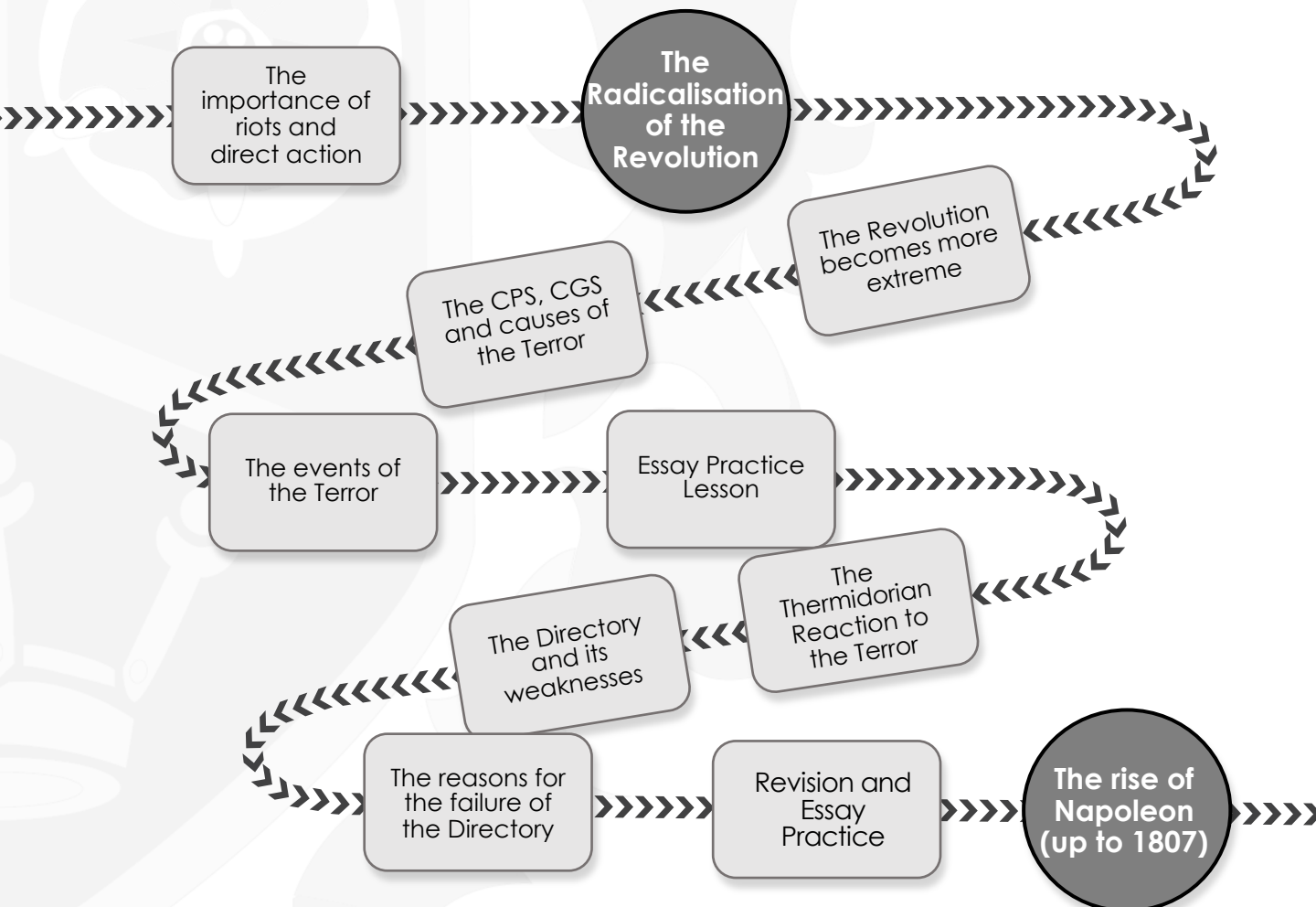


French Revolution and the rule of Napoleon 1774–1815

Spring Term

Between **1792 and 1794**, the Revolution became more **extreme**, before some **stability** was restored. You will develop your understanding of the **interrelation** between the **factors** impacting this and **analyse** how much **true stability** was achieved.

During this process you will develop your understanding of what it means to be a **historian**, including the different **skills** and **processes** involved, as well as develop your **independence**, **self-regulation** and **metacognition** skills. There's also excellent links to a career in **political science** and **law**.



PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT: You will investigate **inequality** in society and different types of government (and how they can contribute to this). **Sovereignty** will be discussed as part of this. They will develop your understanding of what it means to be a **democratic citizen** and debate and deliberate about **societal issues**.
