
OCR Y113: Britain 1930-1997

Autumn Term

1970-1979: Conservative and Labour governments:

We will carry on chronologically from year 12, with making our way through the premierships of Heath, Wilson's second ministry and Callaghan. The 1970s saw huge turmoil and strife economically and politically; so we will explore how each prime minister attempted to ease tensions. This period will see Britain look more familiar to us in some ways, particularly as Britain moves from an imperial power to an equal in the European community.

During this term you will continue to **build** on your essay skills, from **evaluating judgements** to showcasing **mastery** of specific events.



PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT: You will investigate the Labour and Conservative governments 1970-1979 and reach a judgement on their individual successes and failures. By the end of the topic, you will decide whether Britain was the sick man of Europe or not. To conclude the term, we will begin studying Mrs Thatcher's tenure as prime minister.
