
OCR Y113: Britain 1930-1997

1979-1997: Thatcher and Major governments

We will carry on chronologically from 1979, with making our way through the premierships of Mrs Thatcher and John Major. After the turmoil of the 1970s, we will explore Thatcher's economic and social revolution.

During this term you will continue to **build** on your essay skills, from **evaluating judgements** to showcasing **mastery** of specific events.



PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT: You will investigate the Conservative governments 1979-1997 and reach a judgement on their individual successes and failures. By the end of the topic, you will decide whether Britain had been transformed by Mrs Thatcher and why Labour won in 1997.

HISTORY VOCABULARY: Thatcherism, monetarism, sleaze, North/South divide. SKILLS VOCABULARY: consistent analysis, bring in specific evidence to reach a judgement.
