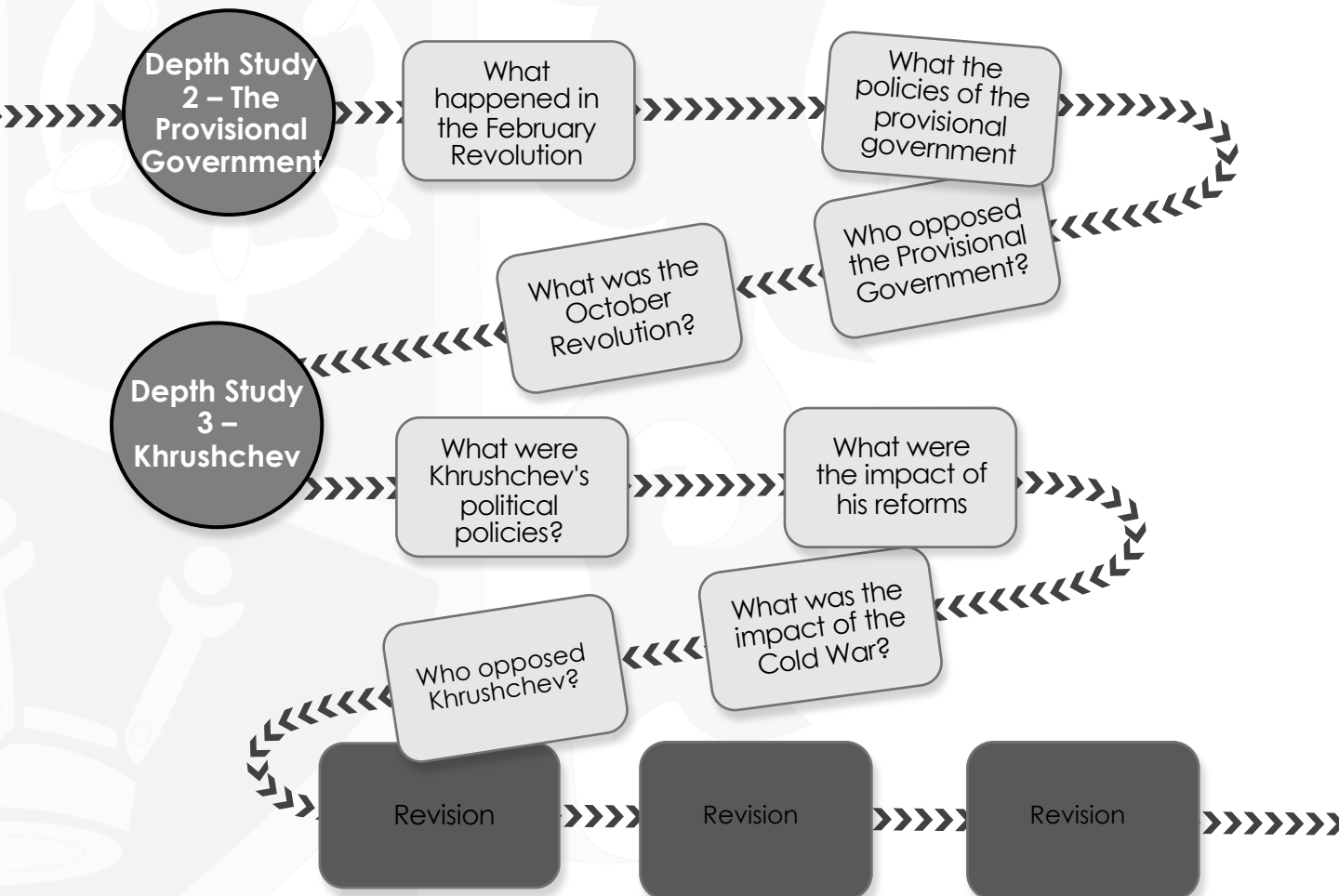


Year 13 – Empire, Nationalities, and Depth Studies

Spring Term

You are going to learn your final 2 topics for Russia and its Rulers. These are the two final depth studies; The Provisional Government, and a study into Khrushchev.

The aim of this is to finish our knowledge of the course, and then leave time to revise the most pressing topics facing us before your exam. We will cover 2 key decisive moments in Russian History, the ending of the Tsars and the failure of democracy, and the death of Stalin and the emergence of Khrushchev within the political vacuum.



TUDOR HABITS: You will continue to look at democracy through the lens of Russian society, and appreciate a society where tolerance for values differs and changes. We will look at destalinisation, and analyse the pure impact of Stalin's terror and the need for reform and reintegration. With the Provisional Government we will seek understanding for how democracy failed, and the opportunity for a less democratic form of government to emerge and dominate the continent.
