

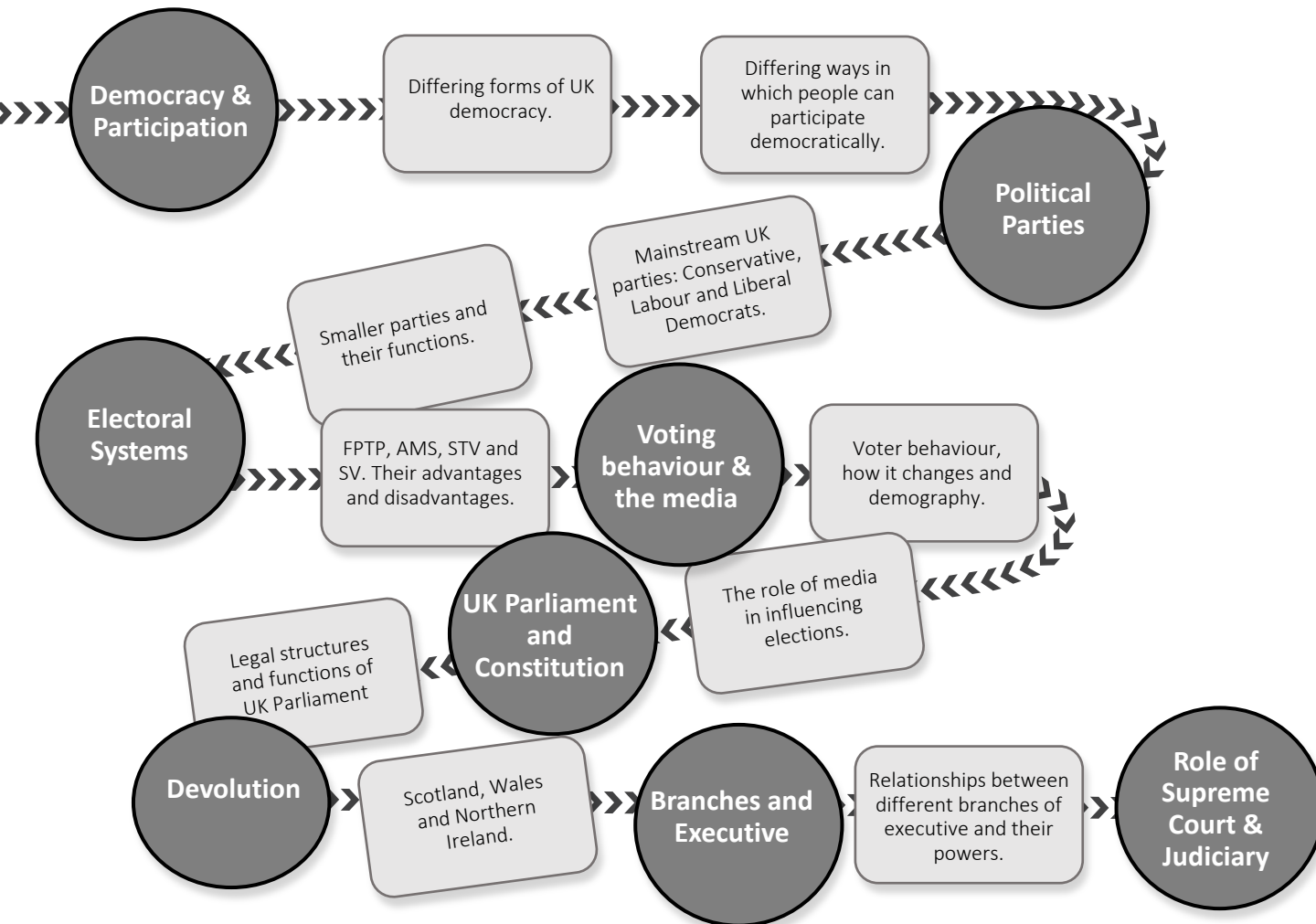
LEARNING JOURNEY Politics

- Students will reflect, revise and consolidate their four UK Government topics from year 12: UK constitution; devolution; relationships with the branches & the Executive, and the Judiciary.
