Read it and produce a written summary in English.
Research the preterite & imperfect tenses. Complete online exercises at <u>www.languageslonline.or</u> <u>g.uk</u> to prove your enhanced understanding and produce a revision aid to demonstrate what you have learnt.	Write 300 words explaining your decision to study Spanish.	Produce a timeline which contains all of the Spanish tenses that you know. Your timeline should include examples and rules for formation of each tense.
