

Maps and the skills associated with them are fundamental to geography. During this topic, you will build on existing knowledge from Key Stage 2 including the location of the world's **oceans** and **continents**, as well as a selection of **countries** and **megacities**. Being able to accurately describe the location of various case studies, starting on a global and ending on a regional scale is imperative throughout geography at TGAS. This exposure to world maps will then allow us to focus more in-depth on the human and physical geography of the UK, along with key geography skills, for example: the use of grid references is revisited in the Year 9 'Cracking Coasts' topic.



TUDOR HABITS AND VALUES: You will begin to develop your grit and resilience as you learn a variety of new skills such as measuring distance on a map and using scale to calculate the real-life distance; and using grid-references to locate places of interest in the local area.
