

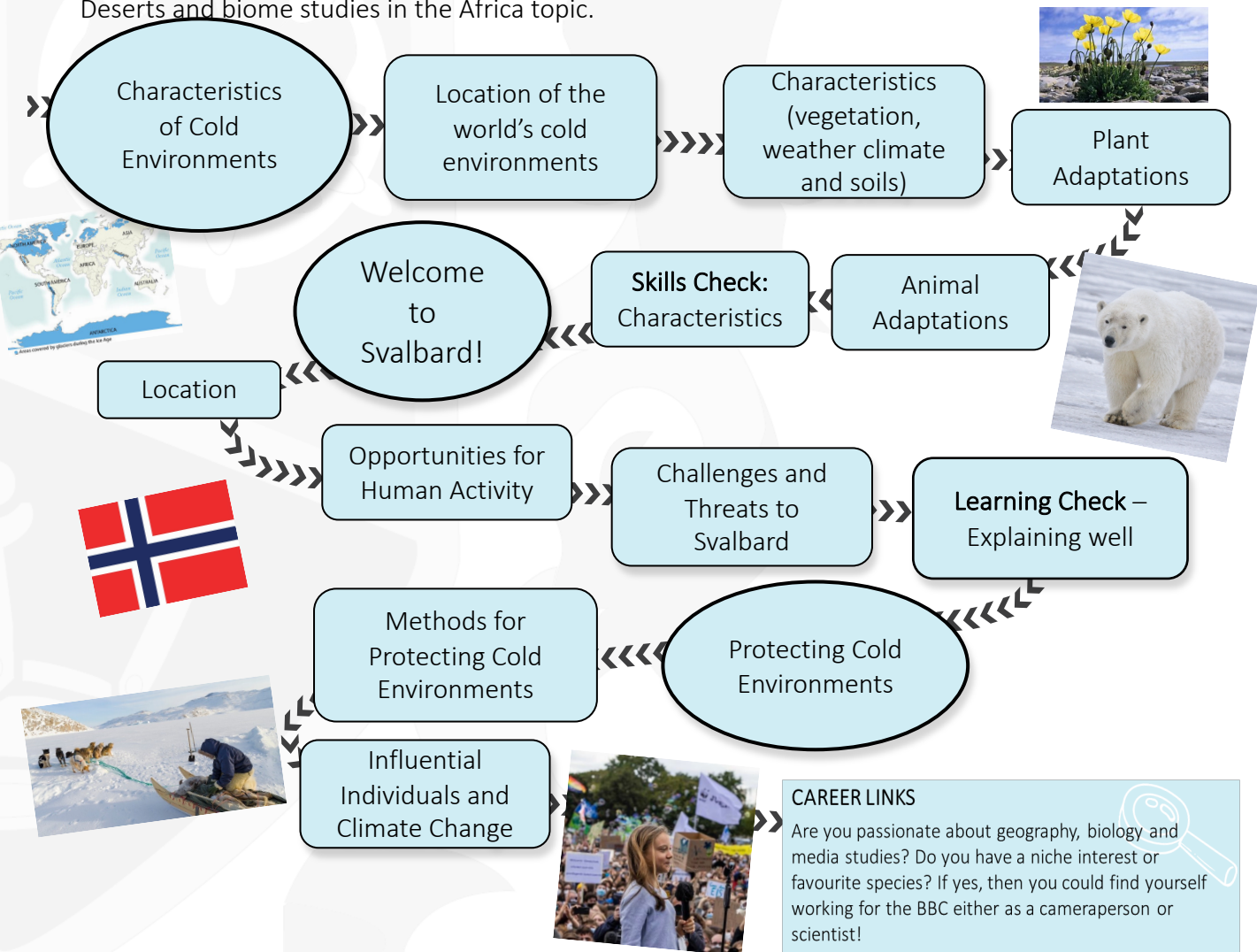

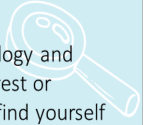
Fantastic Places - Cold Environments

Year 7 Spring Half Term 1

Another fantastic place that you will study in Year 7 is the world's Cold Environments. You will explore the **weather, climate, vegetation and soils** within these areas and consider how these are beginning to change as a result of **human activities**. In addition, you will learn about **how humans have adapted** to live and thrive in cold environments but also how they're causing detrimental effects within these areas. We focus on Svalbard as a case study and you will draw upon skills (particularly drawing and interpreting climate graphs) learned in your previous study of Hot Deserts and biome studies in the Africa topic.
