#### **COURSE BREAKDOWN**

### **Year 10**

Year 10 continues to develop skills learnt in key stage 3 in performance and theory.

Year 10 focuses on Component 1, Devising Drama

Students will work in groups to create a short performance (up to 15 mins).

#### Year 11

Year 11 continues to develop skills in performance and theory in preparation for end of year written examination.

Students study An Inspector Calls (GCSE Set Text) and develop their exam technique.

Year 11 focuses on Component 2, Performing from a Text

Students will work in groups to a short performance linked to the extracts studied and will performed to an external examiner (up to 15 mins)

Students finish the course with a 1 hour 30 minute written paper.
