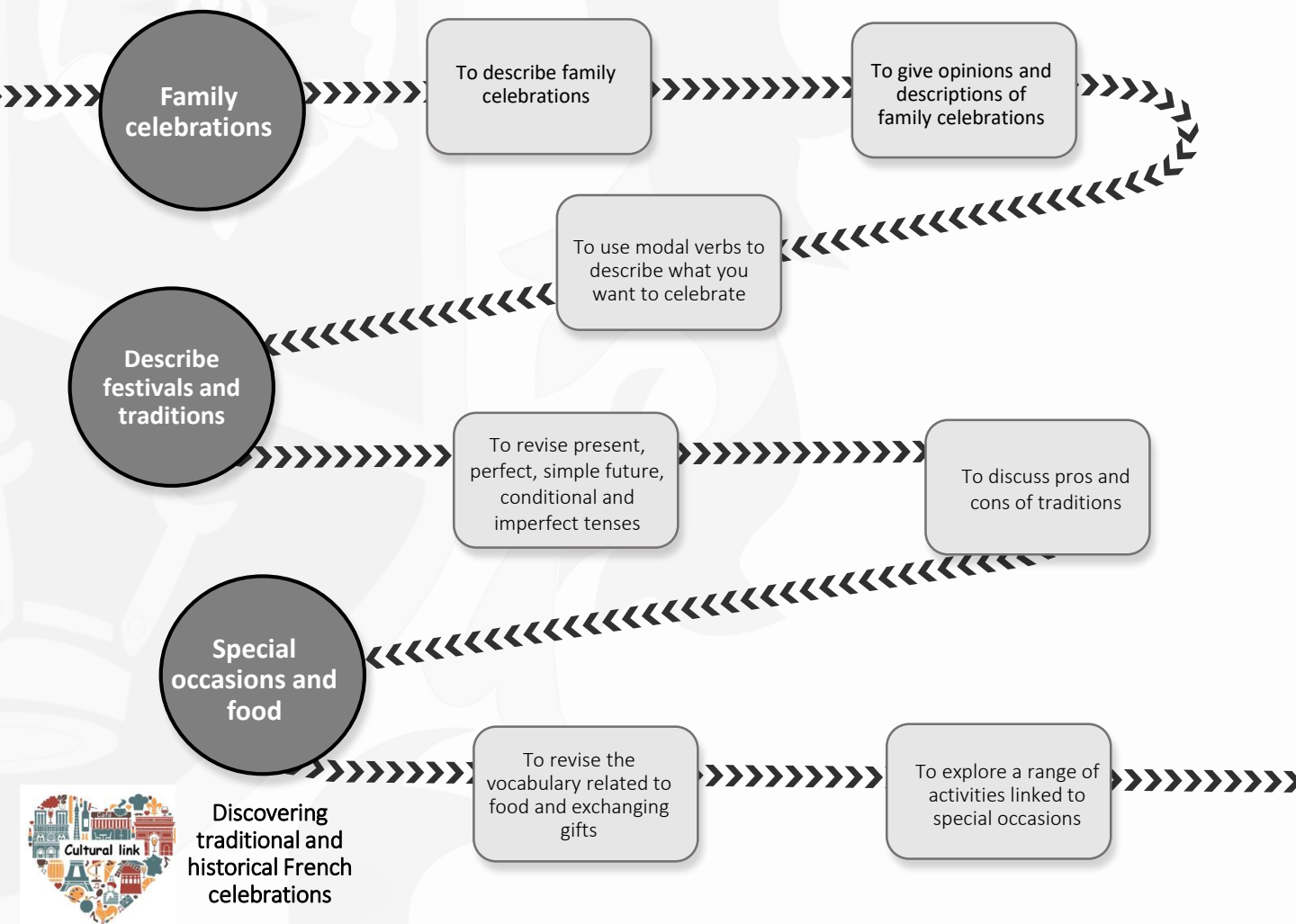


LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH

This is the second time we will cover the colourful topic of customs and festivals. In year 8, you learnt the names of key francophone celebrations and when they occurred in their cultural calendar. You learnt about modal verbs to be able to describe what you like to wear to special occasions and what you must do to organise them. Now you are further developing your ability to narrate past and future celebrations, referring to food and gifts as well as expressing your preferences for certain celebrations. You will have the opportunity to explore other French celebrations such as Bastille Day and compare French customs with British ones.
