

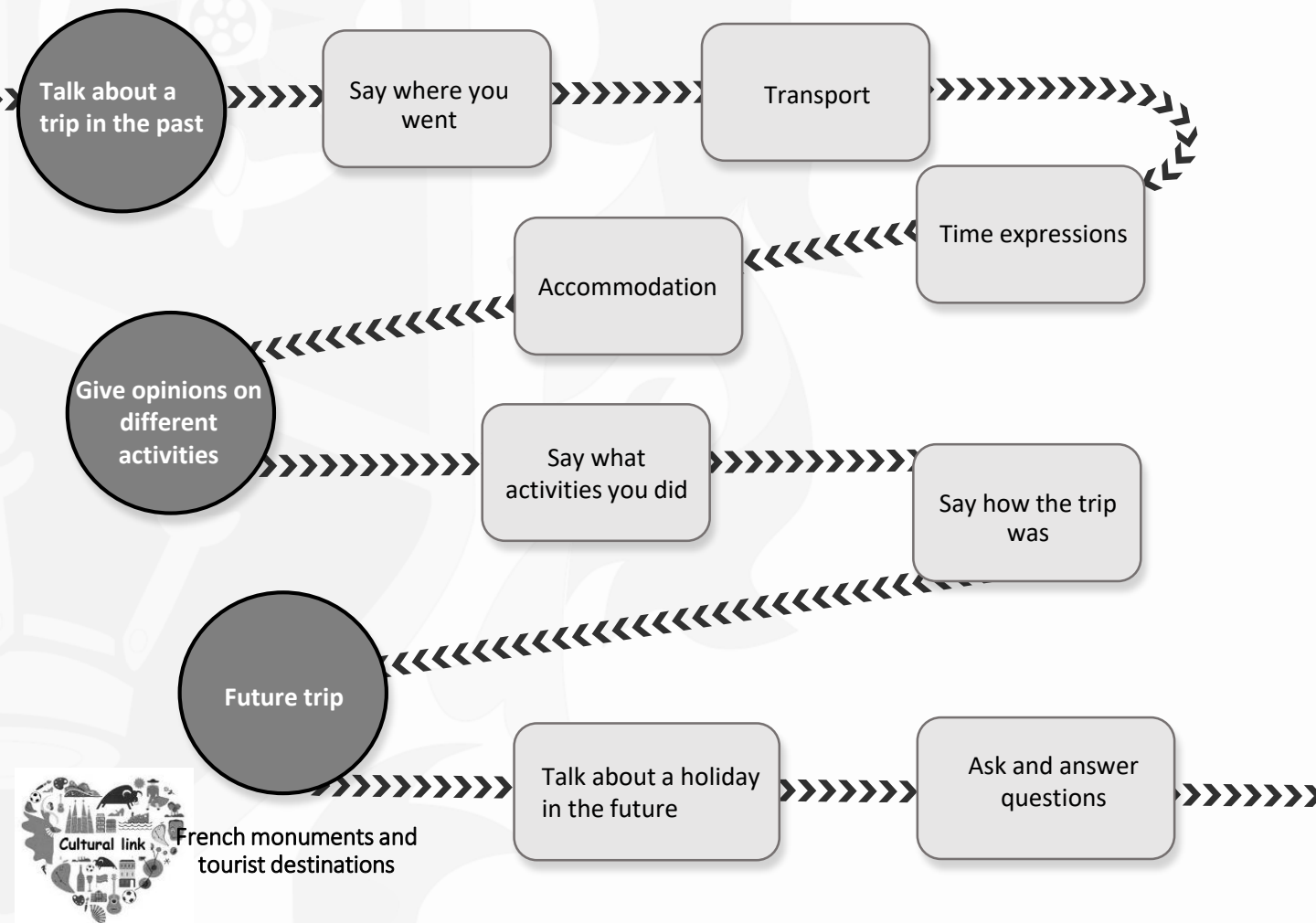

Une excursion du passé (Past day trip)

Year 8 Autumn Term 2

The main objective of this topic is to talk about your trip in the past. To do this, you will continue mastering the use of the perfect past tense, which you discovered in last half term's topic of Media. By the end of this topic, you will be able to use a wider range of past participles, some of which are irregular (e.g.: j'ai bu = I drank). These verbs will be revisited in the year 10 GCSE topic of Travel and tourism. Moreover, there is a lot of focus on sequencing events in this topic, allowing you to broaden your repertoire of time phrases and connectives to add complexity to your narratives both written and spoken.



TUDOR HABITS: As we continue to master the perfect tense and engage with irregular verbs, you will need to demonstrate determination, perseverance and positive self-regulation, remembering to use your grammar reference sheets to achieve grammatical accuracy. Be tenacious as you work towards GCSE!
