
LEARNING JOURNEY GERMAN

Meine Familie und Freunde (my friends and family)

Year 10 Autumn Term 2

In Year 7 we learnt how to give basic physical and personality descriptions of family members. In this topic we will increase the complexity of these descriptions and develop our range of linguistic structures to be able to discuss relationships using reflexive and separable verbs. We are further developing our ability to narrate different types of rapport, as well as use all three tenses to describe past, present and future relationships. You will have the opportunity to put into practice many of

the grammatical structures covered in Year 9, including modal verbs, comparatives and the use of justified opinions, to add detail to your ideas about relationships. To build on this, we will introduce a range of vocabulary relating to marriage and weddings, in order to discuss our own future plans using the future tense, modal verbs and the conditional tense.
