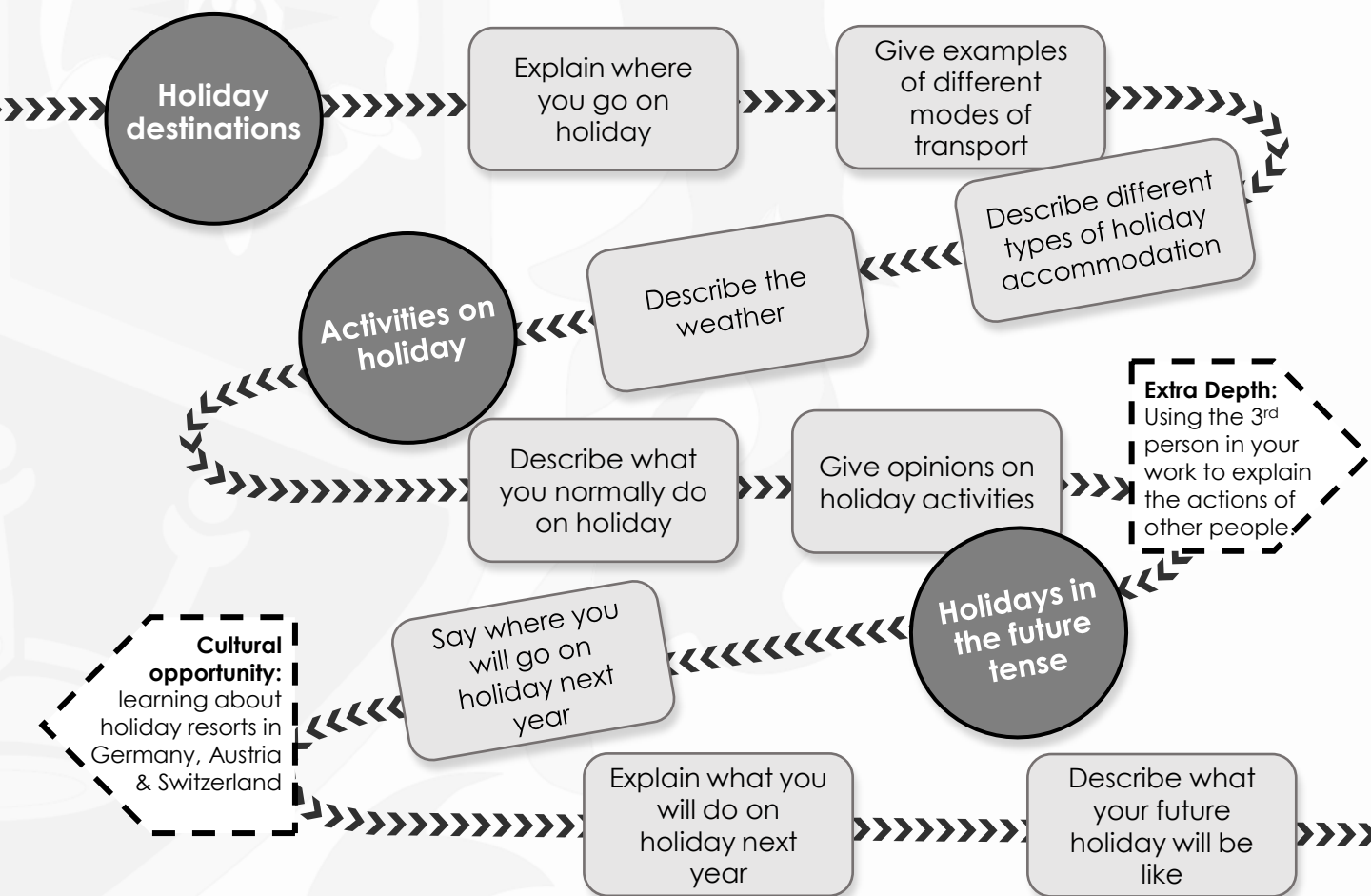

Year 8: Die Ferien (Holidays)

Autumn Term 2

In this topic we will learn basic phrases to talk about **where we go on holiday**, what **accommodation we stay in** and what **transport we use** to get there. We will also learn and use a range of **weather phrases**, which form part of the core basic language for everyday use.. We will then learn a range of **activities to discuss what we do on holiday**, practising the **present tense** endings which we have already used throughout Year 7. We will revisit the **future tense** which we began to practise in Autumn 1 to discuss holidays that you are going to go on in the future. We will also be using **opinion phrases and adjectives** to give our opinions on holidays in the future tense to further consolidate our understanding of this grammatical concept.
