

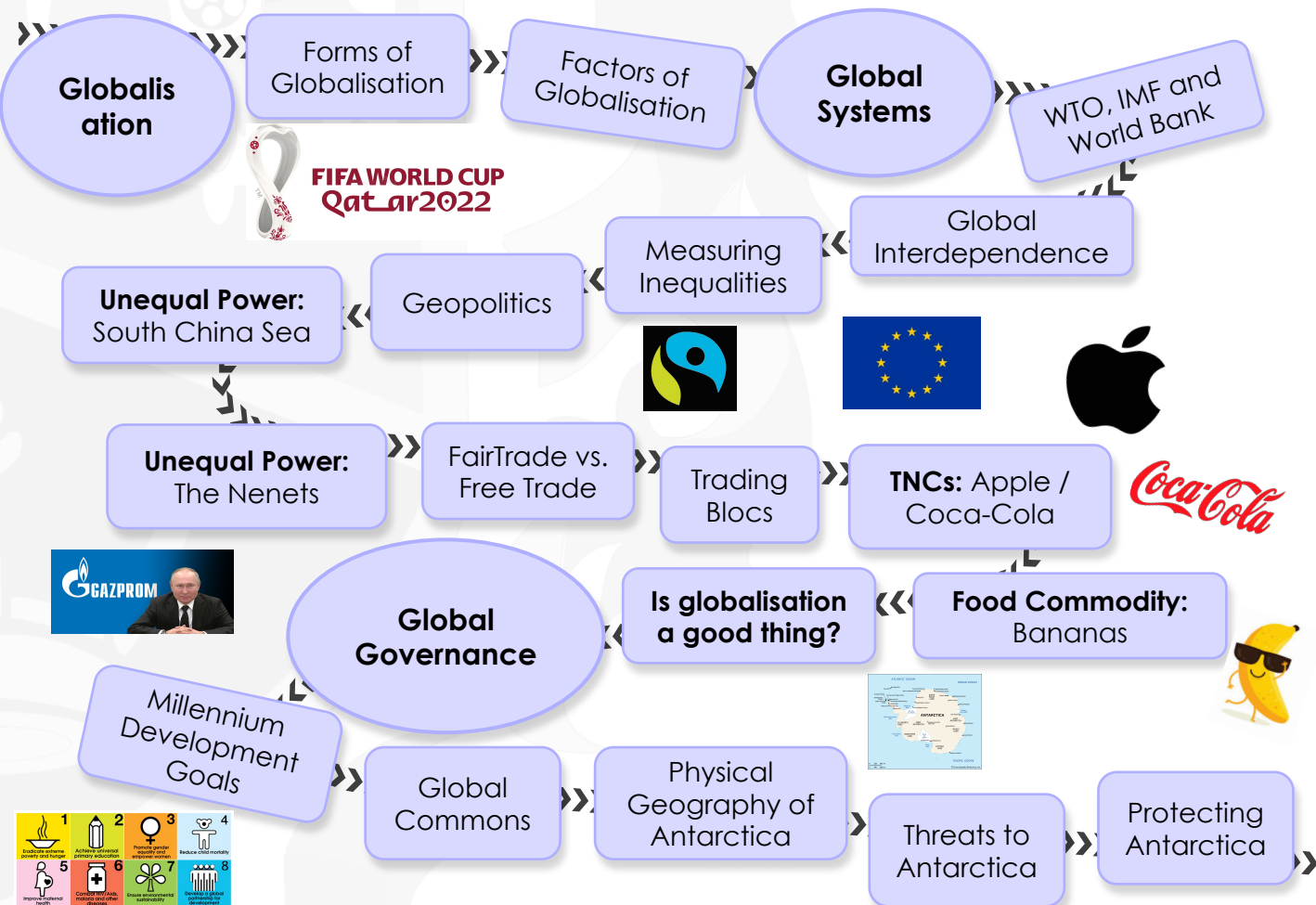

Global Systems and Global Governance

Year 13 – Topic 3

This is your third and final topic as part of the human specification of you're A-Level. Global Systems and Global Governance is somewhat split into two sections with the first introducing Global Systems which focuses on **globalisation** and the factors which have helped the world become more interconnected. This includes global institutions like **The United Nations**, **The IMF** but also the impact of **TNCs**. A key theme of this topic is inequality, and we will look at quantifying this by looking at different measures such as the **Gini Co-efficient**. The second half of this topic draws on knowledge from the first half but applies it to how difficult it is to govern the whole world when we do not have a specific organisation to do so. This then leads us to our case study of **Antarctica** where we look at the **threats and strategies to manage them**.
