

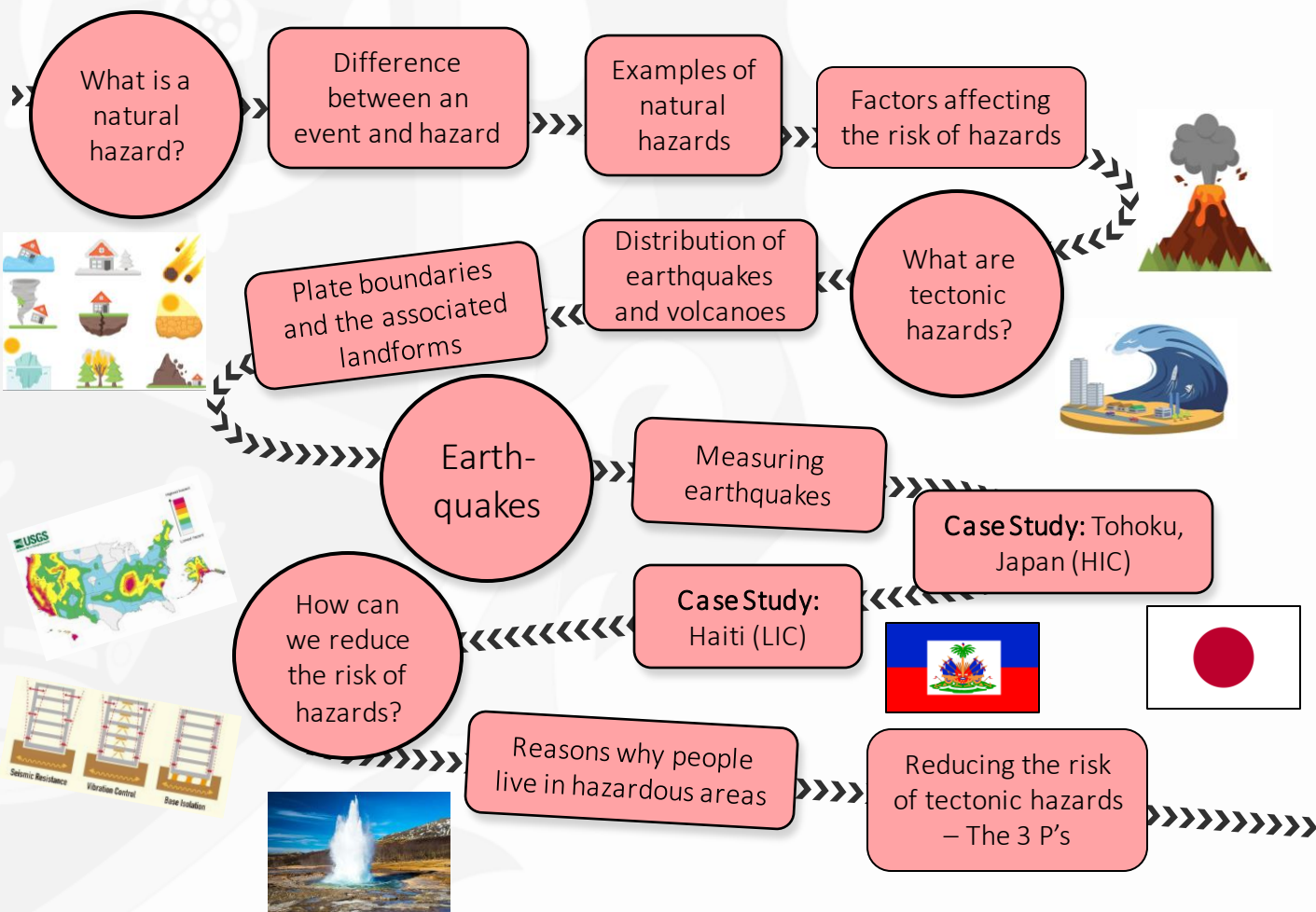

Natural Hazards - Tectonics

Year 10 Autumn Half Term 1

During this topic, you will focus on the impacts associated with tectonic hazards (relating to the structure of the earth's **crust** and the processes within it). You will recap knowledge from the Year 8 'Risky World' topic by looking at the different types of plate boundaries and the **hazards** that accompany them. You will also revisit one of the key threads in geography of how the wealth of a country generally improves the quality of life, by judging how some countries are better prepared to cope with tectonic hazards by comparing Japan (third wealthiest country in the world) and Haiti (the poorest country in Latin America and the Caribbean).



TUDOR HABITS AND VALUES: This topic will require you to demonstrate a lot of kindness and empathy as you recap the devastating effects that tectonic hazards have whilst learning about two new case studies.
