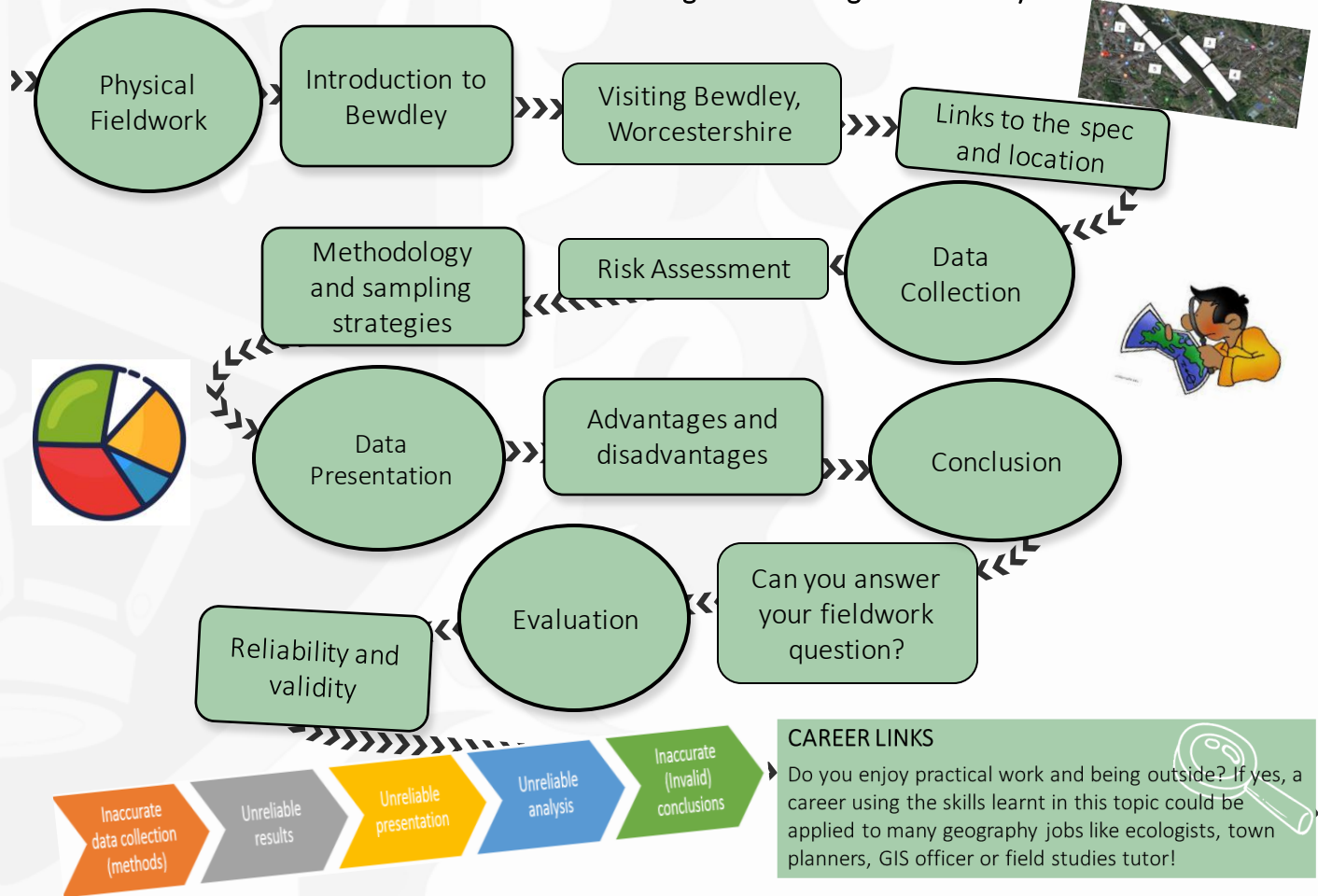


Physical Fieldwork - Bewdley
