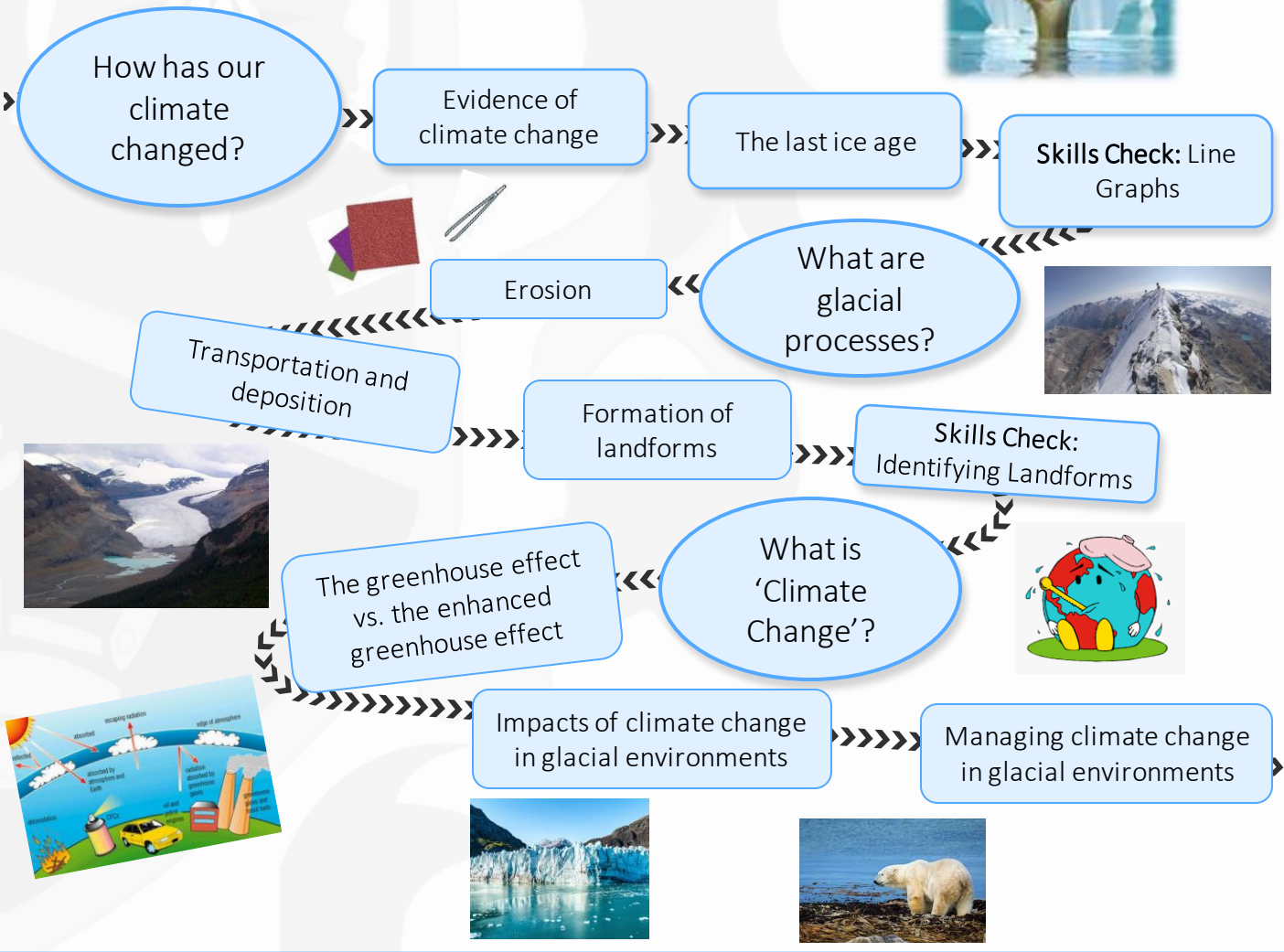

Ice Age

Year 8 Spring Half Term 2

Ice age is a topic that gives insight into how the UK looked 420,000 years ago and helps us to comprehend how the UK's landscape has been shaped into what we recognise today. This topic revisits your understanding of climate change which is a theme visited often in Geography; for example in the topics 'Africa' and 'Hot Deserts' studied in Year 7 and allows you to explore how the world will be impacted melting glacial environments. It also introduces some new geographical processes such as erosion, transportation and deposition which will then be revisited 'Wild Water' and 'Cracking Coasts' in Year 9.
