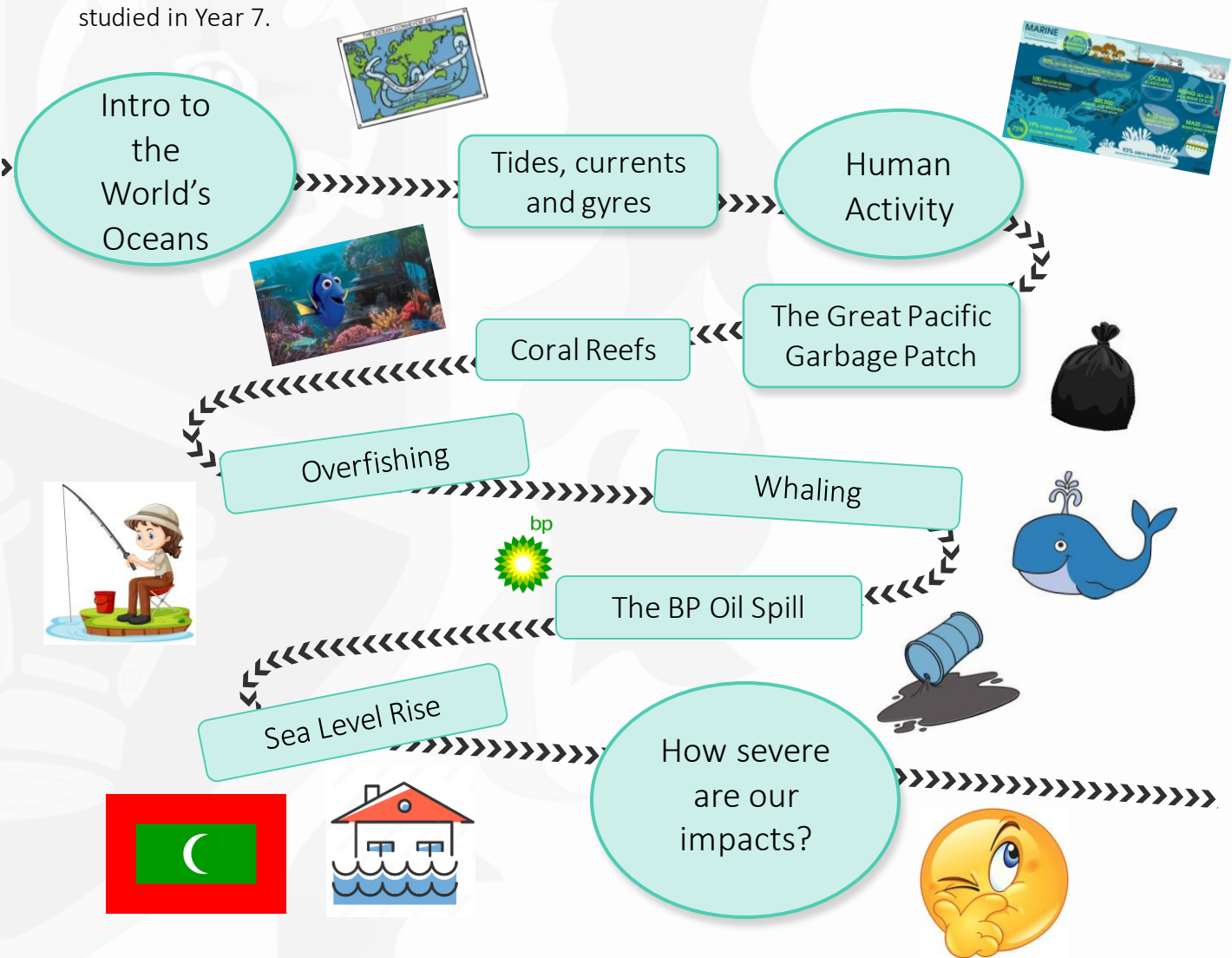

Blue Planet is a topic that gives insight into how the world's oceans are structured, their different components and how humans are interacting with the world's oceans and creating change, both positive and negative! It is often difficult to understand the impact we have on our oceans without knowing how they work! So we look at a lot of aspects of the world's oceans from tides to oil spills! This topic revisits your understanding of how humans change the environment which is a theme visited often in Geography; for example in the Year 8 'Challenging Cities' and 'Hot Deserts' studied in Year 7.



TUDOR HABITS AND VALUES: This topic requires you to look at how humans negatively impact the world around us. You will also have to kindness and empathy when looking at the impacts we have on environments and people around the world.
