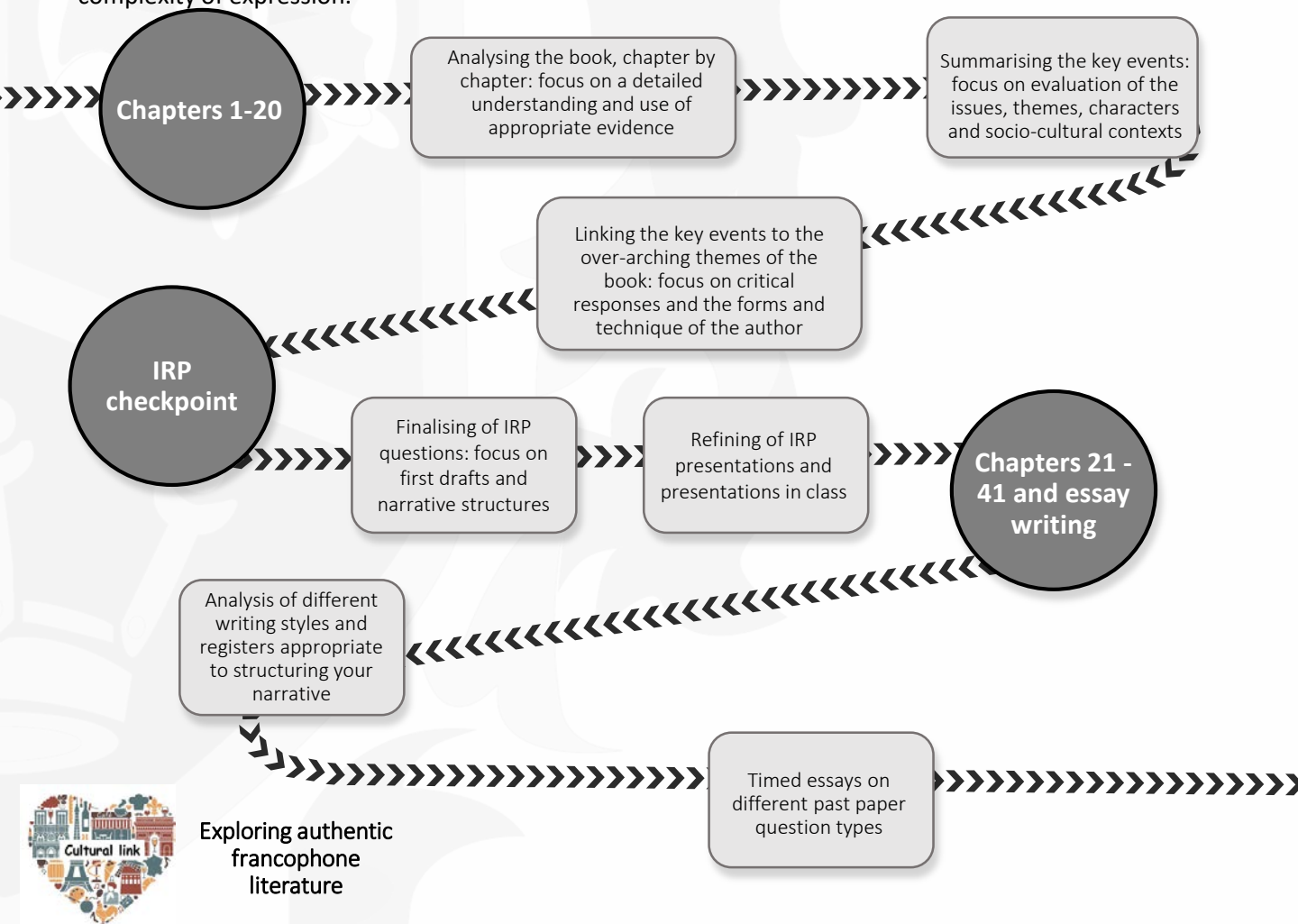


LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH

At the end of year 12, you developed your critical analysis and essay writing through studying a French film, *La Haine*. Interleaved throughout will be grammar practice, which will ensure you master fundamental concepts and build on complexity of expression.
