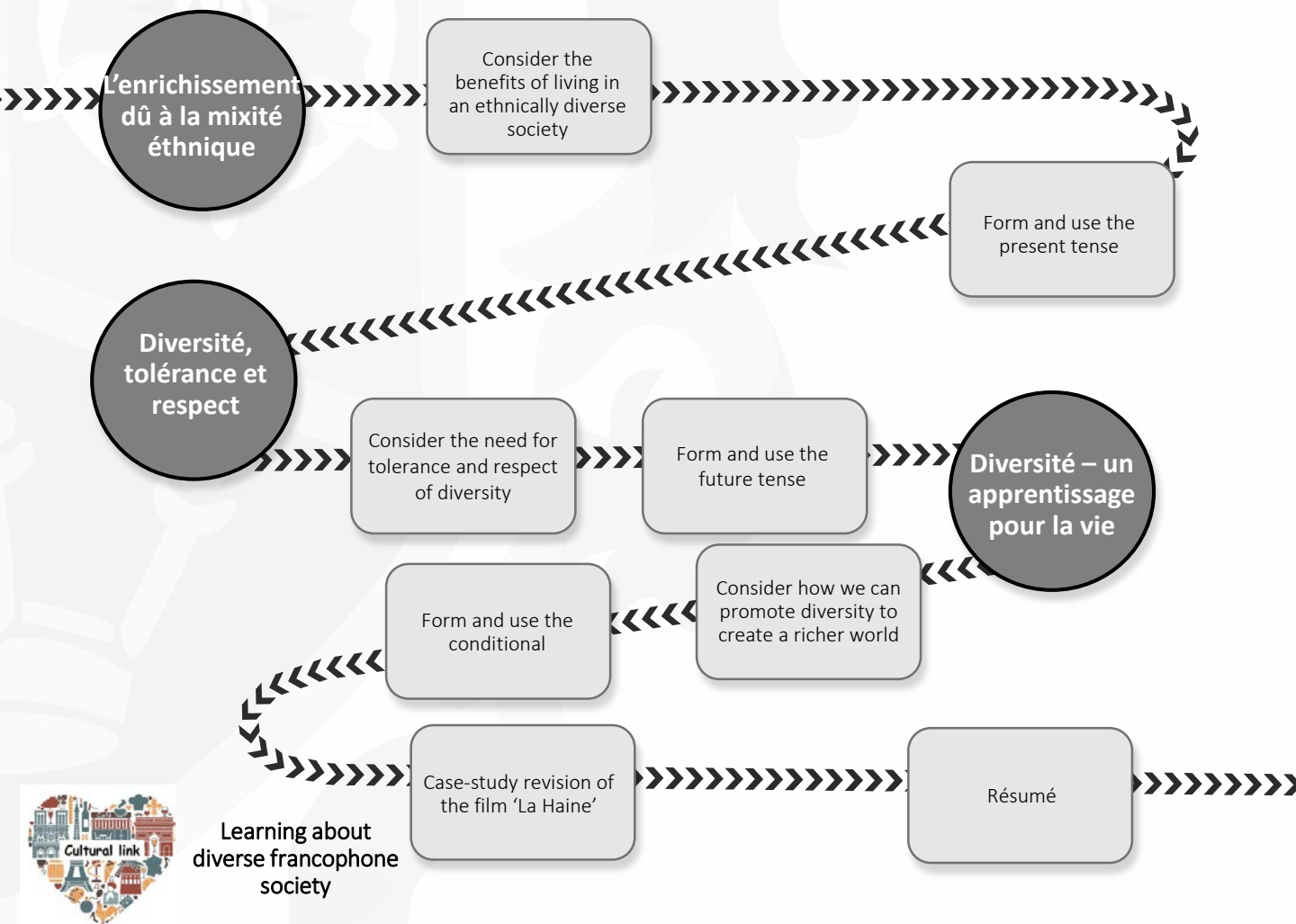


LEARNING JOURNEY FRENCH
