

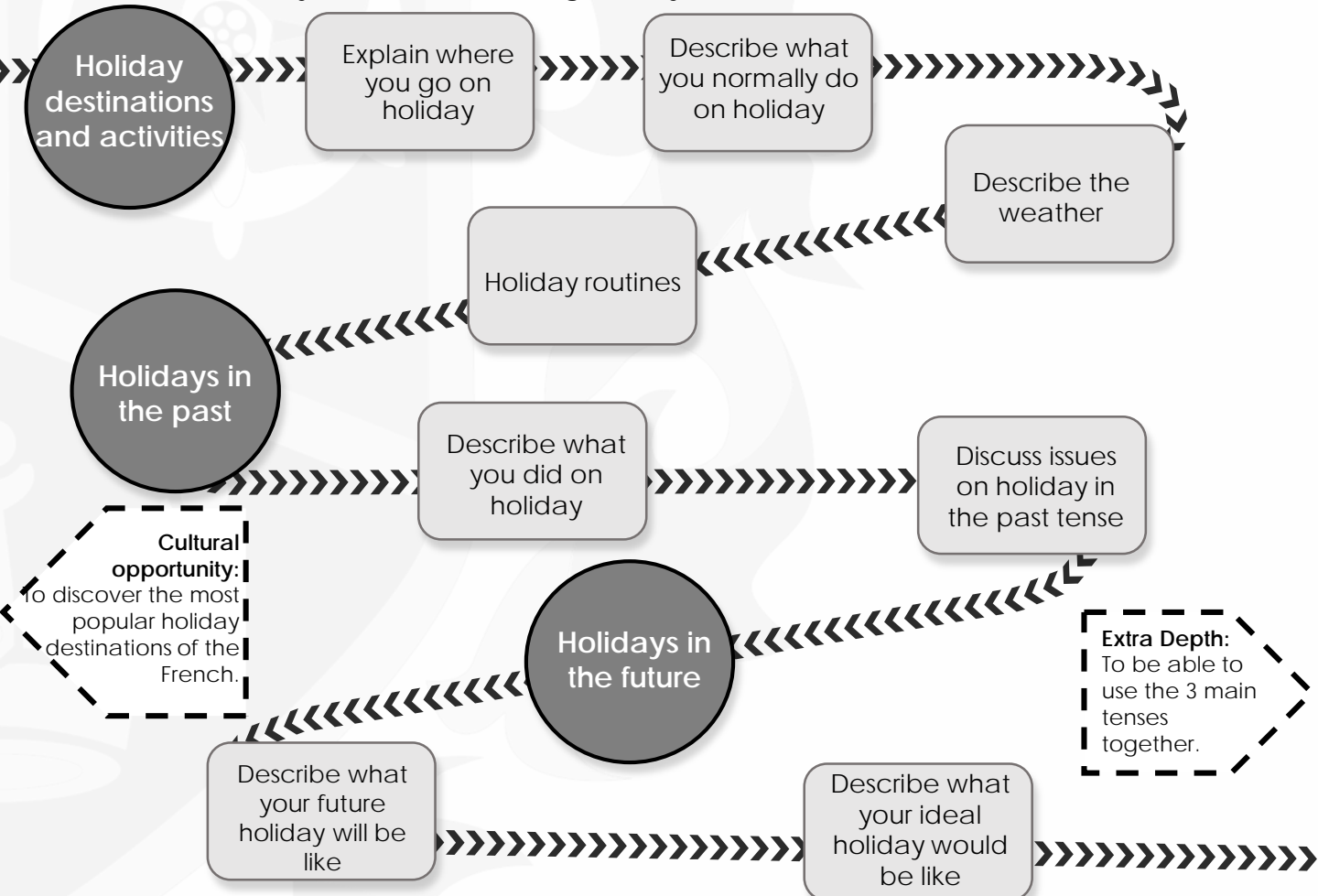

Year 9: Les Vacances (Holidays)

Spring Term 1

In Year 8 you learnt about holiday activities and destinations, as well as the perfect (past) tense. Since Year 7 you have been learning how to express opinions in French with justifications and you will develop your knowledge of opinions and reasons in this topic. The main objective of this topic is to master the use of the three main tenses and discover a brand new tense, the conditional tense. At this stage of the year you will be able to draw upon your knowledge of the perfect tense from Year 8 Autumn term 2 and the simple future tense from Year 9 Autumn term 2 giving you a strong starting point. You will develop your knowledge of vocabulary and structures on the topic of holidays that you covered in Year 8, enhancing your ability to talk about the weather and holiday activities. Additionally you will extend your learning to discuss dream and even disaster holidays while consolidating the key tenses.
