




Year 13 A level Maths

Statistics – Teacher 2

The study of applied mathematics allows you to apply your understanding of pure mathematics to solve contextual problems. It is common to generate a mathematical model to describe a context, gather data by testing your model, leading to a refinement of the mathematical model. The use of applied mathematics is everywhere!

The nature of statistics has significant links to many other subjects such as Geography, Psychology, Economics and Biology. The study of medicine, and similar courses after A levels, use understanding from this module.
