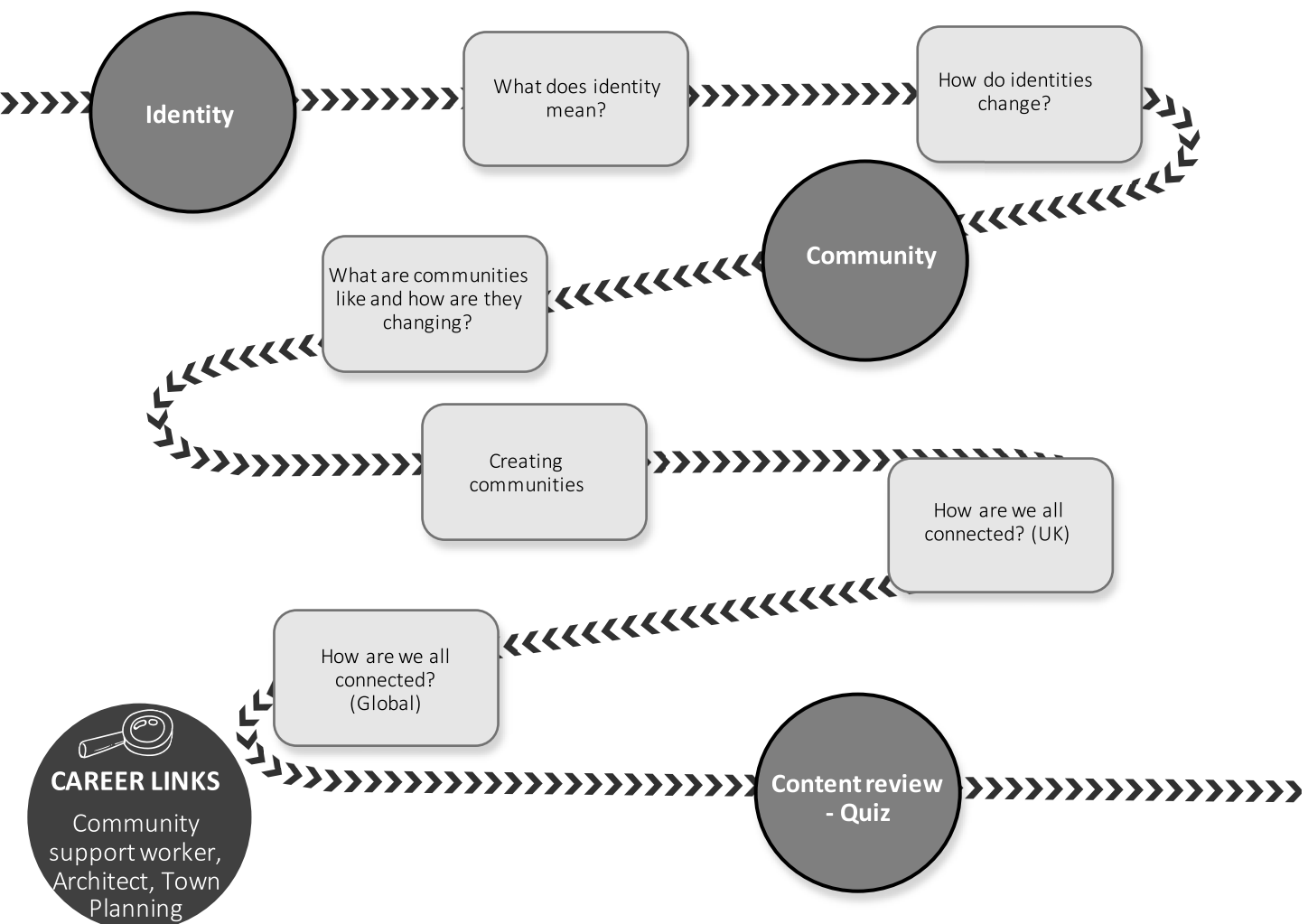

Year 7 Autumn Term 2
